THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (FREE PARKING PLACES) (AMBULANCE VEHICLES) (AMENDMENT No. 2) ORDER 2012

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order—

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 14 May 2012 and may be cited as the London Borough Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Ambulance Vehicles) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2012.
- 2. (1) In this Order the expression "enactment" means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978(**b**) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, the London Borough Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Ambulance Vehicles) (Consolidation No. 1) Order 2008(c), as amended shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) the item in Schedule 1 to that Order which relates to a parking place in Waverley Avenue, Whitton and which is incorrectly numbered as 1/6 were renumbered as item 1/8; and
 - (b) there were added to the items in Schedule 1 to that Order the item numbered 1/2A and as set out in columns 1, 2 and 3 of the Schedule to this Order.

The London Borough Richmond upon Thames (Free Parking Places) (Ambulance Vehicles) (Amendment No. *) Order 201*

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

This order makes provision for an ambulance-only parking bay to be introduced in Kingston Lane, Teddington outside "Garrett House". This will allow ambulances, which may be required to transport elderly or infirm residents of the sheltered housing unit to and from hospital or other clinics or facilities, to park close to the entrance at any time without being obstructed by other parked vehicles. The order provides for an ambulance to use the bay at any time, thus allowing the bay to be kept clear of other vehicles in case of any emergency.
