THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (LOADING PLACES) (AMENDMENT No. 12) ORDER 2003

Made: 14 April 2003

Coming into operation: 28 April 2003

The Council of The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted with the Commissioner of Police for the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended, and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (b) and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 28 April 2003 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Loading Places) (Amendment No. 12) Order 2003.
- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Loading Places) Order 1994 (c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
 - (a) there were added as Schedule 7 to that Order the Schedule and the item numbered 7/3 and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule to this Order:
 - in the Articles of that Order numbered 4, 5 and 7 for the words "Schedule 1 (b) or Schedule 2 or Schedule 3 or Schedule 4 or Schedule 5 or Schedule 6" there were substituted the words "Schedule 1 or Schedule 2 or Schedule 3 or Schedule 4 or Schedule 5 or Schedule 6 or Schedule 7"; and
 - Articles 6 and 7 of that Order apply so that references to a 20 minute limit on (C) stay apply to loading places in Schedule 7.

LOADING PLACES IN RESPECT OF WHICH THE MAXIMUM INITIAL PERIOD FOR WHICH A VEHICLE MAY BE LEFT DURING THE PERMITTED HOURS IS TWENTY MINUTES FOR THE PURPOSE OF LOADING AND UNLOADING.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport)

This Order introduces a loading bay in Warner's Lane, Ham operational between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive for the sole use of commercial vehicles where the maximum period of loading for any one vehicle is 20 minutes.

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order provides a new loading bay for commercial vehicles having a maximum period of loading of 20 minutes in Warner's Lane, Ham. The loading bay will be operational between 9am and 5pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive. The loading bay, together with recently introduced parking places and waiting and loading restrictions, will improve conditions for shoppers and traders.
