THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (LOADING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO.6) ORDER 1997

Made 1st September 1997

Coming into operation 15th September 1997

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended, and the Road Traffic Act 1991 (b) and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on 15th September 1997 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Loading Places) (Amendment No.6) Order 1997.
- 2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of the Order, the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Loading Places) Order 1994 (c), as amended, shall have effect as though:-
  - (a) there was added as Schedule 4 to that Order the Schedule and item numbered 1 and set out in columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the Schedule to this Order;
  - (b) in the Articles of that Order numbered 4, 5 and 7 for the words "Schedule 1, Schedule 2 or Schedule 3" there were substituted the words "Schedule 1, Schedule 2, Schedule 3 or Schedule 4";
  - (c) in the Articles of that Order numbered 6 and 7 for the words "Schedule 2" there were substituted the words "Schedule 2 and Schedule 4".
