THE RICHMOND CARD SCHEME

Part A – Application for and issue of a RichmondCard

Any person who is the owner or driver of a passenger vehicle, a goods carrying vehicle, an invalid carriage or a motor cycle may make application to the Council or a person authorised by the Council in that behalf for the issue of a RichmondCard.

An application may be made in person or by other such means as the Council may determine by the completion of an application form obtainable from them and on payment to them of the charge specified in paragraph (3) of Article 5 of this Order.

The application shall include such particulars and information required by such application form to be supplied.

On receipt of the charge the Council, being satisfied as to the validity of the particulars and information provided, shall issue to the applicant a RichmondCard. The card will be encoded with particulars of the vehicle registration mark and other details sufficient for a ticket machine to recognize the correct parking charge tier or tariff applicable to that vehicle.

Part B – Credit available on the RichmondCard

The applicant may, when applying for a card, pay an additional sum to the Council and the Council, when issuing the card, shall add a credit to that card of an equal value. At any time thereafter, the person to whom the card was issued may add further credit to that card by payment to the Council of a sum in cash or by other means at places or by other methods as the Council may from time to time determine.

Part C – Use of the RichmondCard when paying for parking charges

Any person to whom a RichmondCard has been issued in respect of a particular vehicle may pay the parking charge in respect of that vehicle for any parking place specified in Schedule 1 by inserting the said RichmondCard into the ticket machine provided by the Council at or in respect of that parking place. The ticket machine will indicate the charge appropriate to the vehicle. When payment has been made, the machine will issue a parking ticket valid for the parking period requested by the said owner or driver. If the driver had requested that payment should be made by deducting credit from the balance held of the RichmondCard the ticket parking meter will deduct the charge from the balance before ejecting the card, always provided that the credit held on the said RichmondCard is sufficient for the parking charge in question.

Part D – Other conditions

The Council, at its absolute discretion, may limit the number of RichmondCards issued to any applicant, and may require the production and surrender of the said card or cards. The Council may similarly limit the maximum and minimum amounts which may be added to the credit available on any one RichmondCard, the maximum value which may be held on any such card and determine the method or manner by which such credits may be added to the said cards.

SCHEDULE 4 (Continued)

Part D – Other conditions (continued)

The Council may require the applicant or holder of a RichmondCard to surrender the card, or the Council may disable the card such that it cannot be used as described in Part C above if the Council or its agents are satisfied that the card had been deliberately or fraudulently used to secure a discounted charge other than that for which the vehicle in question is eligible under the terms of this order. In such circumstances, the Council shall give notice to the applicant or card holder that he should surrender the card (and the applicant or card holder must do so within 2 working days of the notice being served) or inform the applicant or card holder of its intention to disable the card, such notice or other communication being in writing and sent to the applicant's or card holder's last known address by first class post or by email to the applicant's last known account.

In the event that a card holder should lose the card he may report the card as being lost and the Council will immediately disable the card such that it cannot be used as described in Part C above. The Council will, if so requested, issue a replacement card having the same credit value encoded thereon as it would appear to the Council had been held on the original card at the time it was reported as lost, provided that the card-holder pays to the Council the charge specified in paragraph (4) of Article 5.

BANK HOLIDAYS

- 1 For the purposes of this order, a bank holiday shall be regarded as being any of the days specified in the following paragraphs:-
 - (a) New Years Day (1st January) unless that day falls on a Saturday or a Sunday in which case the bank holiday shall be on the following Monday.
 - (b) Easter Monday (the day following Easter Day).
 - (c) May Day bank holiday (the first Monday of May).
 - (d) Spring bank holiday (the last Monday of May).
 - (e) Late summer bank holiday (the last Monday of August).
 - (f) Christmas Day bank holiday shall be 28th December in any year when 25th December is a Saturday, and 27th December in any year when 25th December is a Sunday.
 - (g) Boxing Day bank holiday shall be 28th December in any year when 26th December is a Saturday and 27th December in any year when 26th December is a Sunday.
- 2 Any day which may be appointed by the Queen as a bank holiday under section 1(3) of the Banking and Financial Services Act 1971**(a)** shall not be regarded as a bank holiday for the purposes of this Order.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

This Order:-

- introduces a general increase in parking charges at all off-street car parks of 25%;
- introduces a scale of discounted parking charges which are dependant on the engine size or carbon dioxide emissions of the vehicle in respect of which the parking charge will be due;
- introduces a “RichmondCard” being a device by which ticket machines may issue a parking ticket at a discounted tariff;
- introduces changes in tariff at four car parks in Teddington, such that parking periods of 30 minutes at a rate of 50 pence per 30 minutes apply in each car park, up to a maximum stay which varies from car park to car park, these charges being subject to the same discounted charges as stated above;
- removes from the order the free car park at Station Road, Teddington which was discontinued in September 2003;
- consolidates the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2002 and a number of later amendment orders and notices of variation.

The Order is arranged in a number of Parts to allow the measures to be introduced in stages.

A separate order is being made in respect of similar differential parking charges at on-street pay and display parking places. The RichmondCard, whether issued under the provisions of either order, will be interchangeable at off-street and on-street pay and display ticket machines.

The discounted charges may be payable in respect of vehicles which meet certain standards based on engine size for older vehicles or on CO2 emissions for newer vehicles. For general convenience, the ranges of CO2 emissions are based on the same vehicle bands as (in general) apply to vehicle excise tax as used by DVLA. This Order replicates that scale of CO2 emissions in Schedule 5, Table B. The corresponding table in the proposed order was based in the Chancellor’s budget statement of 2008 rather than on the figures used in the Finance Act of 2009.

This Order uses the convention by which the differential parking charges are defined as Tier 3”, “Tier 2” and “Tier 1”. For the purposes of general publicity and the design of tariff boards, these charges are known as the standard charge, the medium charge and the low charge respectively.

**The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Off-Street Parking Places)
(Consolidation No. 5) Order 2009**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

This Order introduces differential parking charges at off-street car parks according to the size of engine or amount of CO₂ emissions produced by the vehicle using the car park. This is a continuation of the Council's policy first implemented in 2007 by introducing differential charges for on-street parking permits.

The Council wishes to encourage motorists using the on-street parking places and off-street car parks within the borough to use vehicles with low levels of carbon dioxide (CO₂) emissions by linking the parking charge to CO₂ emissions.

The reduction in CO₂ gases emitted within the borough which these Orders seek to achieve supports the Council's priority to take positive steps to tackle climate change. By concentrating on the key "greenhouse gas" when setting a parking charge, the aim is that residents and others will make better informed choices when purchasing new or replacement vehicles, emissions of CO₂ and other particulates will be lower, and, as a consequence, the local air quality will be improved.

For owners and drivers of older vehicles, where the registration documents do not specify levels of CO₂ emissions, the scale of parking charges will be related to the engine size of the vehicle.

This Order is to bring into effect the decision of the Council's Cabinet on 27 April 2009 and relates solely to the on-street parking places. A separate order makes similar provisions for on-street pay and display parking bays.
