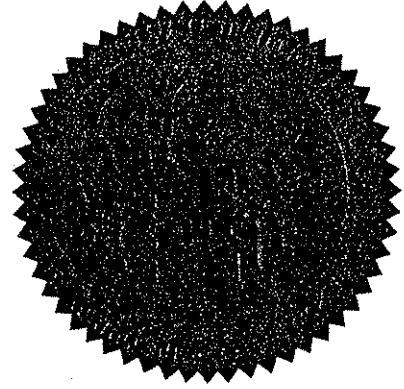
Coming into operation 8th August 1994

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, having consulted the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), as amended, and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 8th August 1994 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (St Margaret's Area and Queen's Road, Twickenham)(One-way Traffic) Order 1994.
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the roads or length of road specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in column 3.
3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to:
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer or traffic warden in uniform; or
 - (b) any person who causes or permits any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

1	2	3
1.	Bridge Road, Twickenham	South-west to north-east
2.	Broadway Avenue, Twickenham	North-east to south-west
3.	Kenley Road, Twickenham	North-east to south-west
4.	Queen's Road, Twickenham between its junction with King Street, Twickenham and the south-eastern kerb-line of Holly Road, Twickenham	South-east to north-west
5.	Sidney Road, Twickenham	South-west to north-east

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order, but is intended to indicate its general purport). This Order makes permanent the experimental one-way traffic movements that were introduced to certain roads in Twickenham by Traffic Management Orders 1993/13 and 1993/15.
