

Resident Permit for walking 5-6dogs in the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames

A Public Space Protection Order that was adopted on 16 October 2017, restricts the number of dogs that can be walked by one person to a maximum of 4 in Council owned or managed land. The council has approved the granting of 18 licences for Professional Dog Walkers to walk up to 6 dogs on 6 named sites, but is also granting a resident permit for residents to walk 4-6 their own dogs on any council owned or managed land.

Resident Permits will be granted for a period of 3 years from the date of issue, after which a new application must be made. To apply for a resident permit, please complete this form and return by:
