KNELLER HALL SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT (SPD)

ADOPTION STATEMENT

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (As amended), notice is hereby given that the Kneller Hall Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was formally adopted by the Council on 6th April 2020.

The Kneller Hall SPD is focused on Kneller Hall, which is Grade II listed, together with ancillary buildings, playing fields and service areas that support the functioning of the Royal Military School of Music. The SPD provides specific guidance for the Kneller Hall (Whitton) Site Allocation (SA 14) as contained within the Richmond Local Plan (2018). The Kneller Hall SPD forms part of the Council's planning policy framework and is now a material consideration in the determination of any future planning applications for the site.
