
CHILD ADMISSION POLICY



UNDER 4 YEARS

- One responsible person
- One child with or without an approved flotation device
- All remain in the Designated Safe Area (DSA)

UNDER 4 YEARS

- One responsible person
- Two children with approved flotation devices
- All remain in the DSA

BETWEEN THE AGES OF 4-8 YEARS

- One responsible person
- Up to two children with or without approved flotation devices
- All remain in the DSA if any are non-swimmers or wearing approved flotation devices

MIXED AGES

- One responsible person
- One under 4 yrs with an approved flotation device
- One 4-8 yrs with or without an approved flotation device
- All remain in the DSA
- Designated Safe Areas are: Teaching Pool and up to 1.5m in the Main Pool and Outdoor Pool
- A responsible person is defined as; being 16 or over (exception may be made for parents under 16 accompanying their own children), capable of supervising those in their care, and able to exercise judgement on the conduct of both themselves and those in their care
- No child under 8 will be admitted without an accompanying responsible person
- Weak and non-swimmers must stay in the Teaching Pool or up to the 1.5m mark in the general swim area of the Main Pool and Outdoor Pool
- Any responsible person supervising children less than 8 must be in the water with them. Viewing from poolside is not acceptable
- Whilst in the water the responsible person must have constant supervision and close contact with weak or non-swimmers
