**Queens Rise and Nos. 71-89 Queens Road area Parking consultation –
DECISION NOTIFICATION LETTER**

We wrote to you in July 2021 seeking your views on extending The Alberts controlled parking zone (CPZ), Zone G to Queens Rise and part of Queens Road.

The summary of the consultation results is as follows:

Response rate:

38 documents delivered, 6 returned / completed online, (16%)

'Q5. To what extent do you agree that a CPZ should be implemented in your area? Strongly agree 3 (50%), Agree 0 (0%), Neither agree / disagree 0 (0%), Disagree 1 (17%), Strongly disagree 2 (33%)'

Total in favour of / against CPZ 50%/50%

Q5. (BREAKDOWN PER ROAD)


Queens Rise 2 (67%) in favour, 1 (33%) against
Queens Road 2 (67%) against, 1 (33%) in favour

The results from the consultation showed a low response rate (16%) and insufficient support for the scheme. Due to this, we will not be progressing proposals to extend the CPZ at this time.

The outcome of this process formed part of a report which featured the main issues raised by respondents and how they were considered by officers.
