

Information sheet for the Mayor's Art Competition

- Entry is £10 per person (entrants must be aged 17 years and over)
- Choose a date and book your art session
- Your ticket includes entry to Asgill House gardens where you will have 3 hours to be inspired, sketch, study and start creating your artwork. You can then take it home to perfect! There are fine views of Asgill from the river, the tow path, bridge and other points
- An aspect of Asgill House should be included in your artwork.
- You may use any materials you like to create your picture - watercolours, oil paints, charcoal, pencils etc
- The artwork can be presented on any material but be no larger than A3 size 16.5 x 11.7 inches (unframed)
- The artwork can be presented on any material
- The artwork can be framed in any style (if you are framing it)
- Please take extra care if using oil paints etc whilst at Asgill House gardens as these could stain the stonework, garden furniture, or grass
- There is no need to print your booking confirmation or ticket as your name will be on the artist guest list at the door
- Please be aware that there are no refreshments or toilet facilities available on site, so please ensure you factor in comfort breaks during your visit. There are local amenities nearby .

Completed artwork

- The closing date for entries to be received is Wednesday 21st September 2022
- Please deliver your artwork to the reception at York house from Mon- Fri 9am -5pm
Or send your entry to York House, Richmond Road, Twickenham, TW1 3AA
Please make sure it is labelled with your name, phone number and email address
- The Mayor will choose the winner on 22nd & 23rd September and inform the winner shortly after
- The winner will then be invited to the Mayor's Parlour at York House, Twickenham to meet the Mayor and receive their prize
- The winner will have their artwork displayed in the Mayor's parlour for the duration of the Mayor's term (May 2023)
- The winner will also be invited to a reception at Asgill House hosted by the Mayor in May '23
- Please collect your artwork from York House from 26th September onwards. Unfortunately, we cannot return artwork entered in the competition that has not been collected .
