

BUCKINGHAM PRIMARY SCHOOL: TRANSFER OF SPECIALIST PROVISION TO CLARENDON SCHOOL

The London Borough of Richmond upon Thames is proposing to remove provision reserved for pupils with special educational needs at Buckingham Primary School Buckingham Road, Hampton with effect from 28 September 2015 and to replace it with provision at Clarendon School.

Buckingham Primary School is a community school for pupils aged 3 to 11. It currently has special educational provision for up to 8 pupils aged 4 to 7 with severe and complex learning difficulties including autistic spectrum disorders.

The council proposes to close the Buckingham Specialist Provision and to provide additional places at Clarendon School, Hanworth Road, Hampton, TW12 3DH. Clarendon School is a community special school providing day places for up to 155 pupils aged 7 to 19 with complex learning difficulties.
