

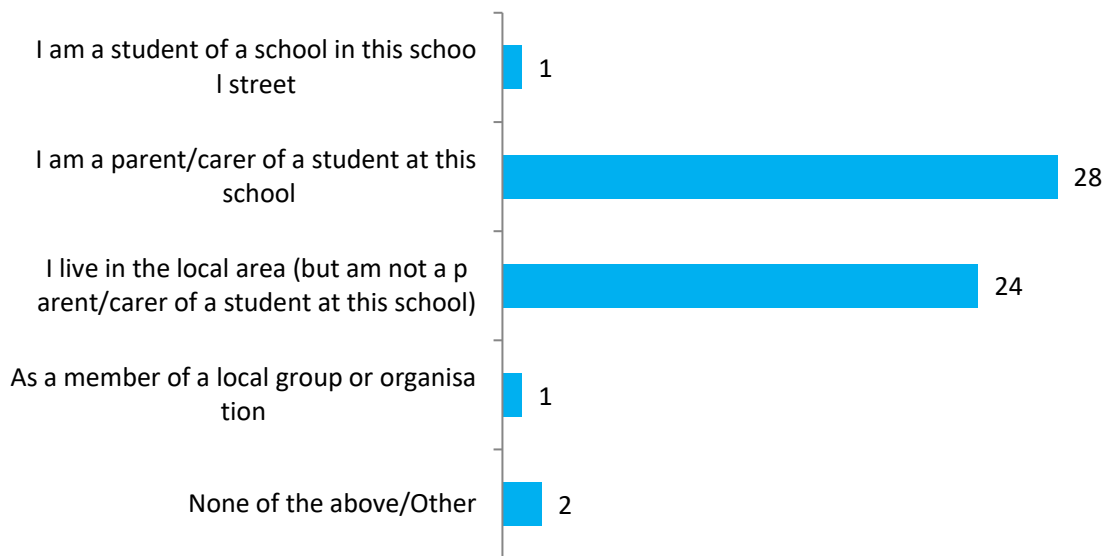

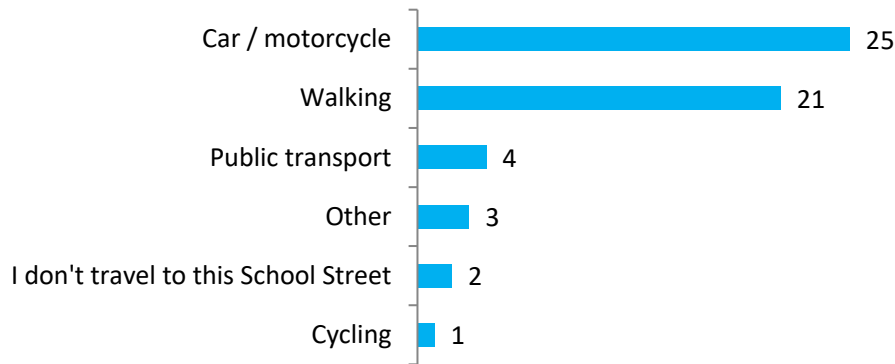

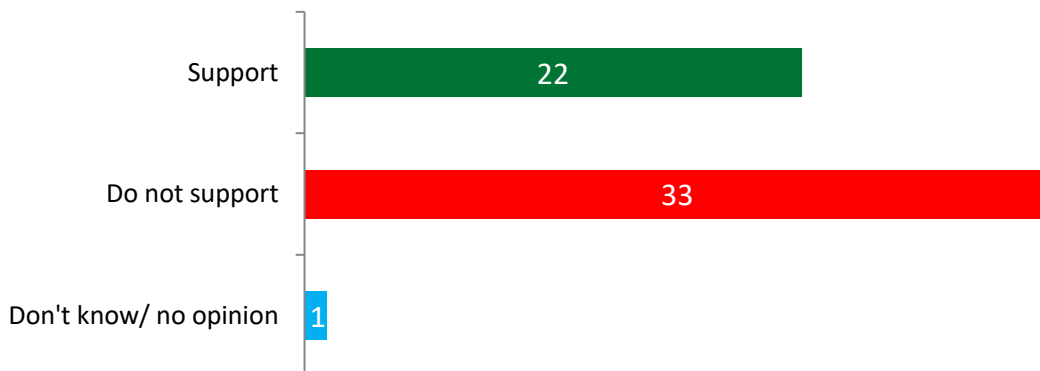

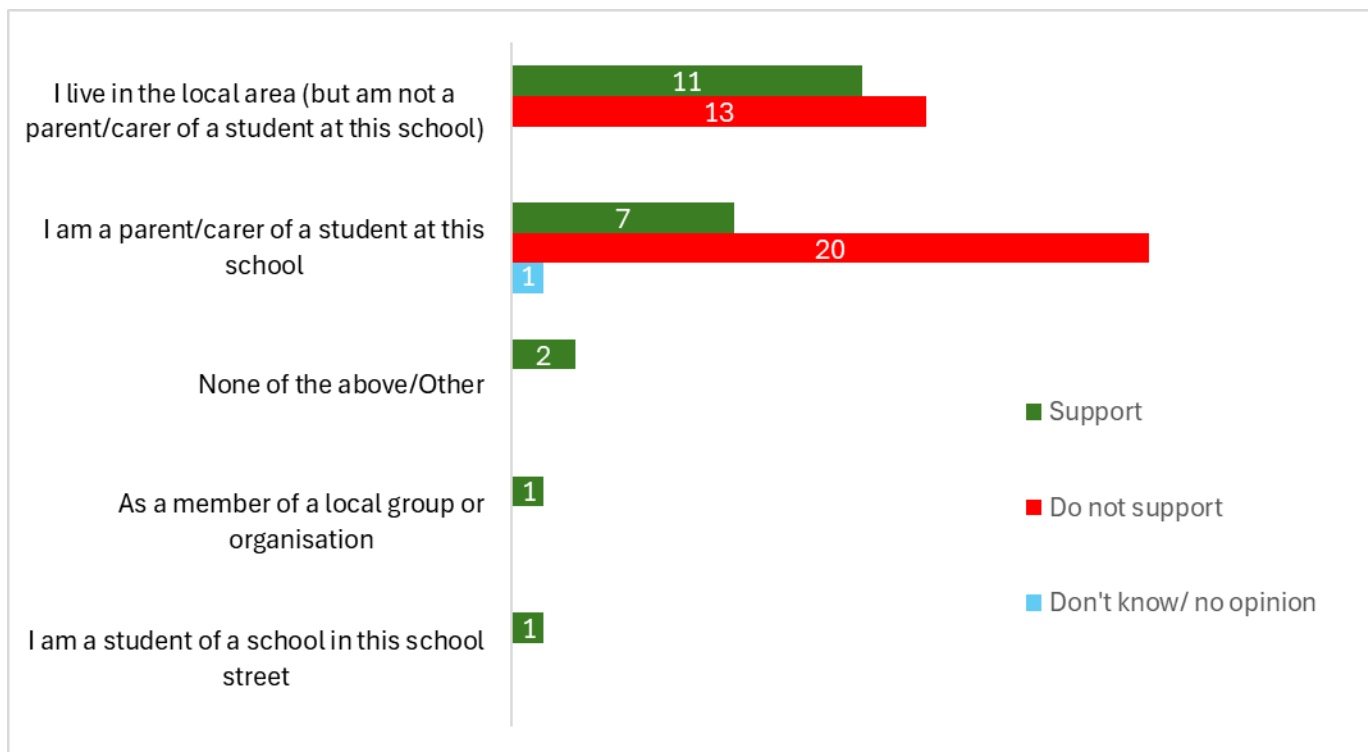

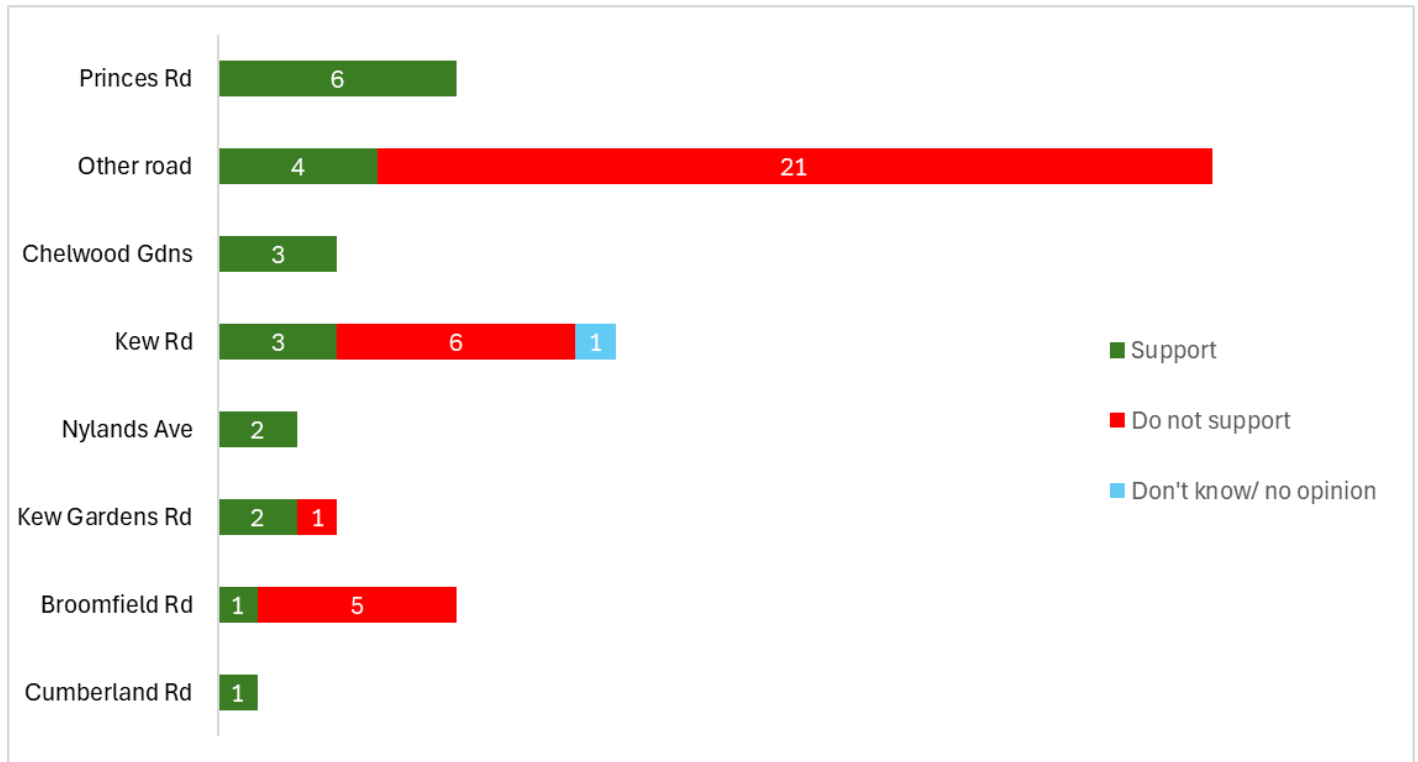

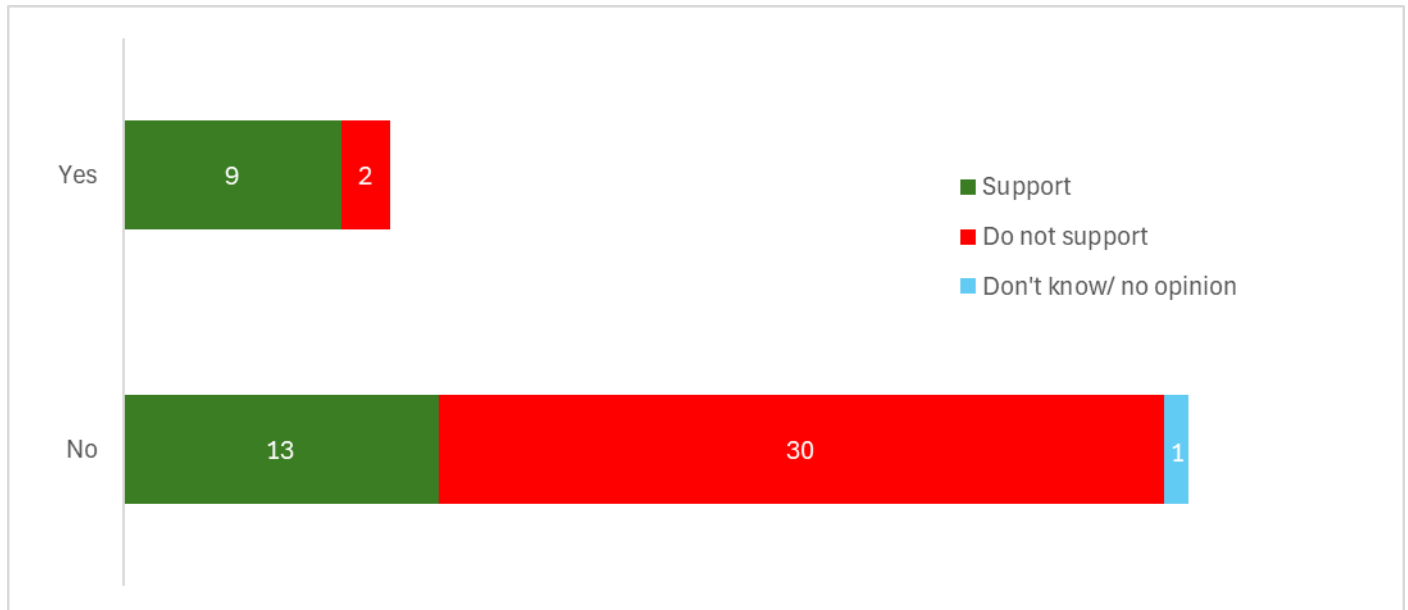
The graph below shows respondents' answers to this question based on the capacity in which they were responding to the survey.



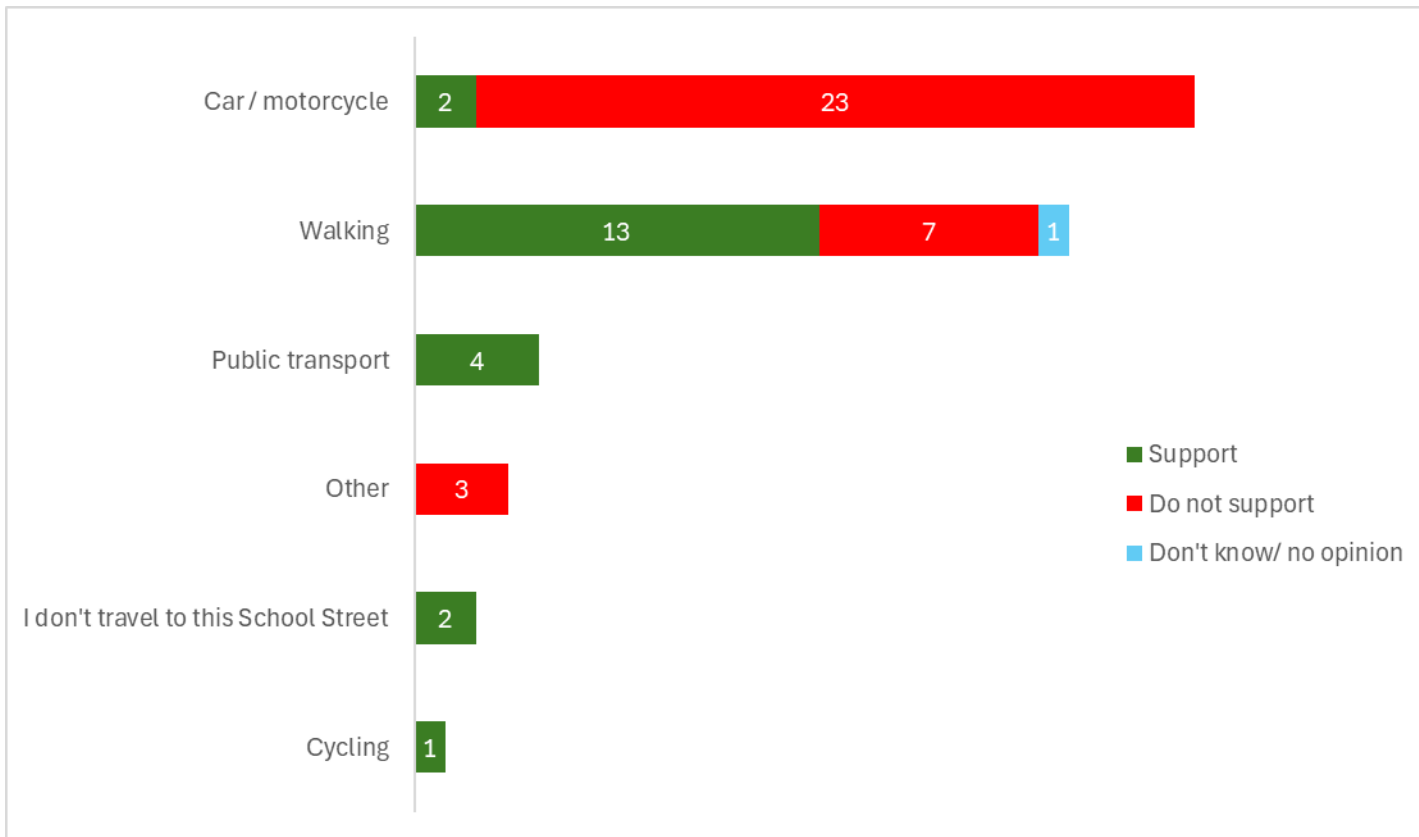
The graph below shows respondents' answers to this question based on the street they live on. Please see Appendix 1 for a pie chart showing support levels for each of the below streets.



The graph below shows respondents' answers to this question based on whether they live in the School Street restricted area.

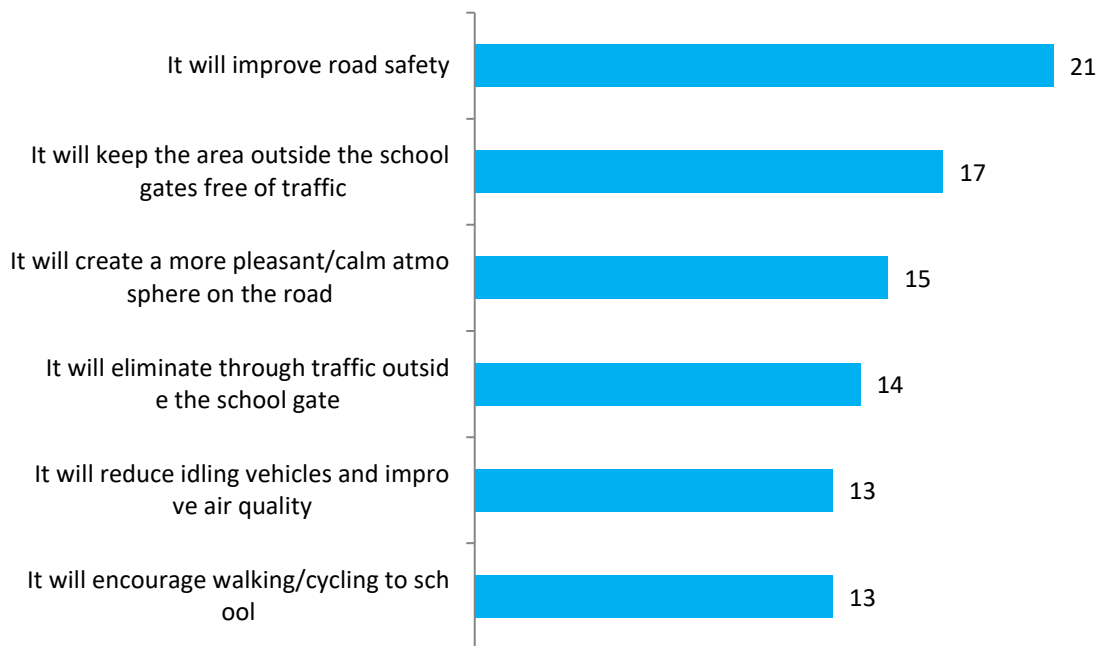


The graph below shows respondents' answers to this question based on their current MAIN mode of transport for getting to/from this School Street.



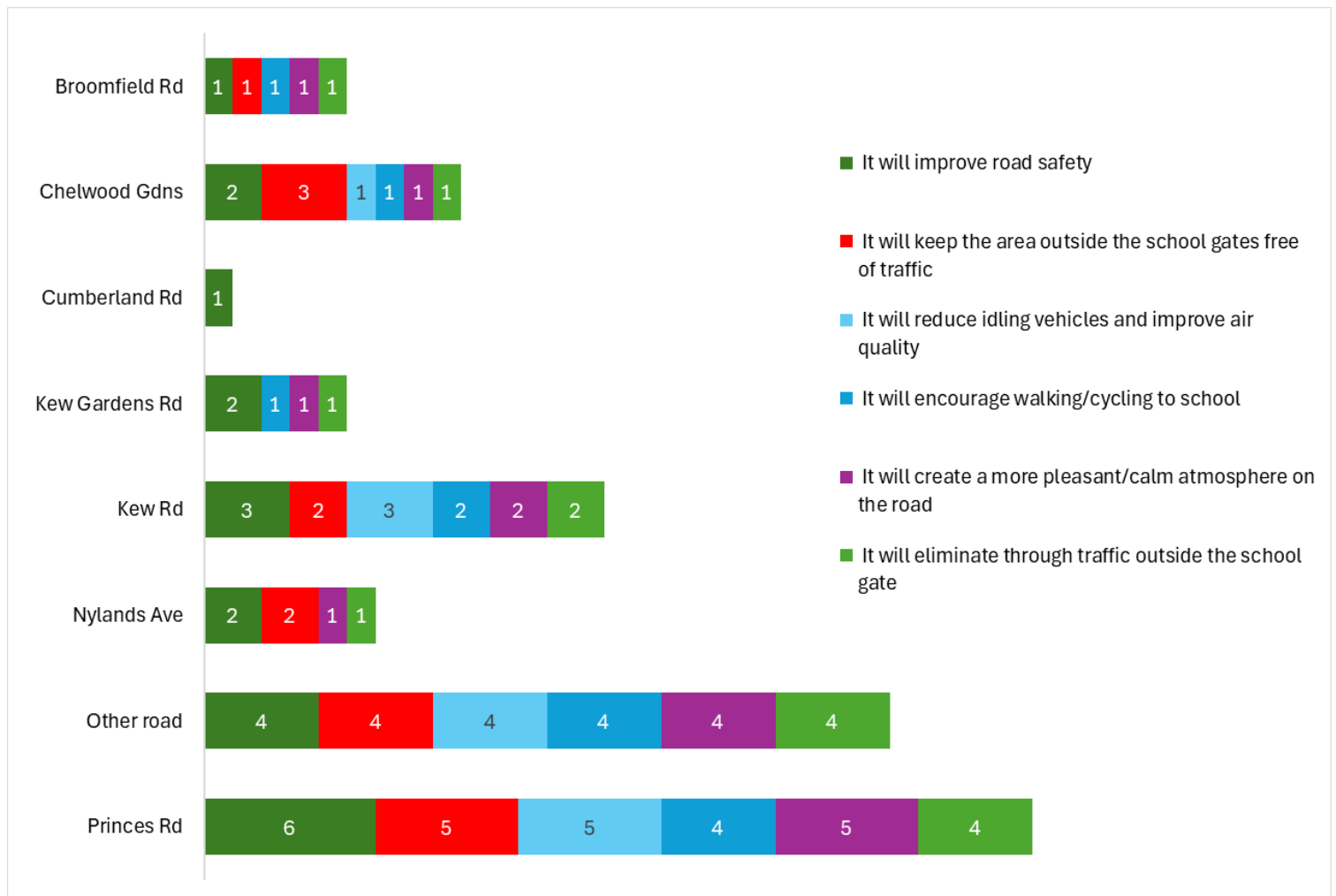

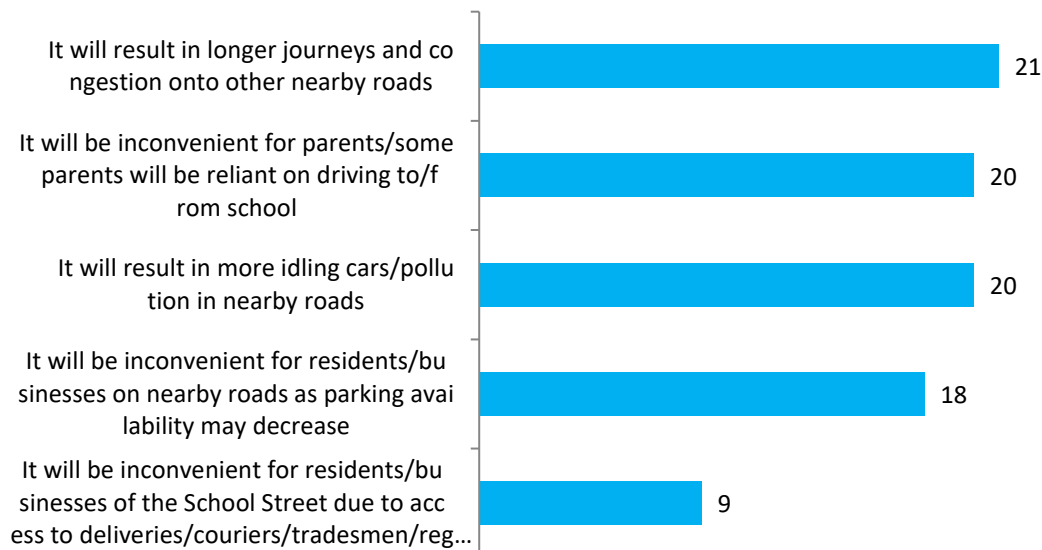

The graph below shows respondents' answers to this question 'Please tell us why you support the proposed school street' based on the street they live on.



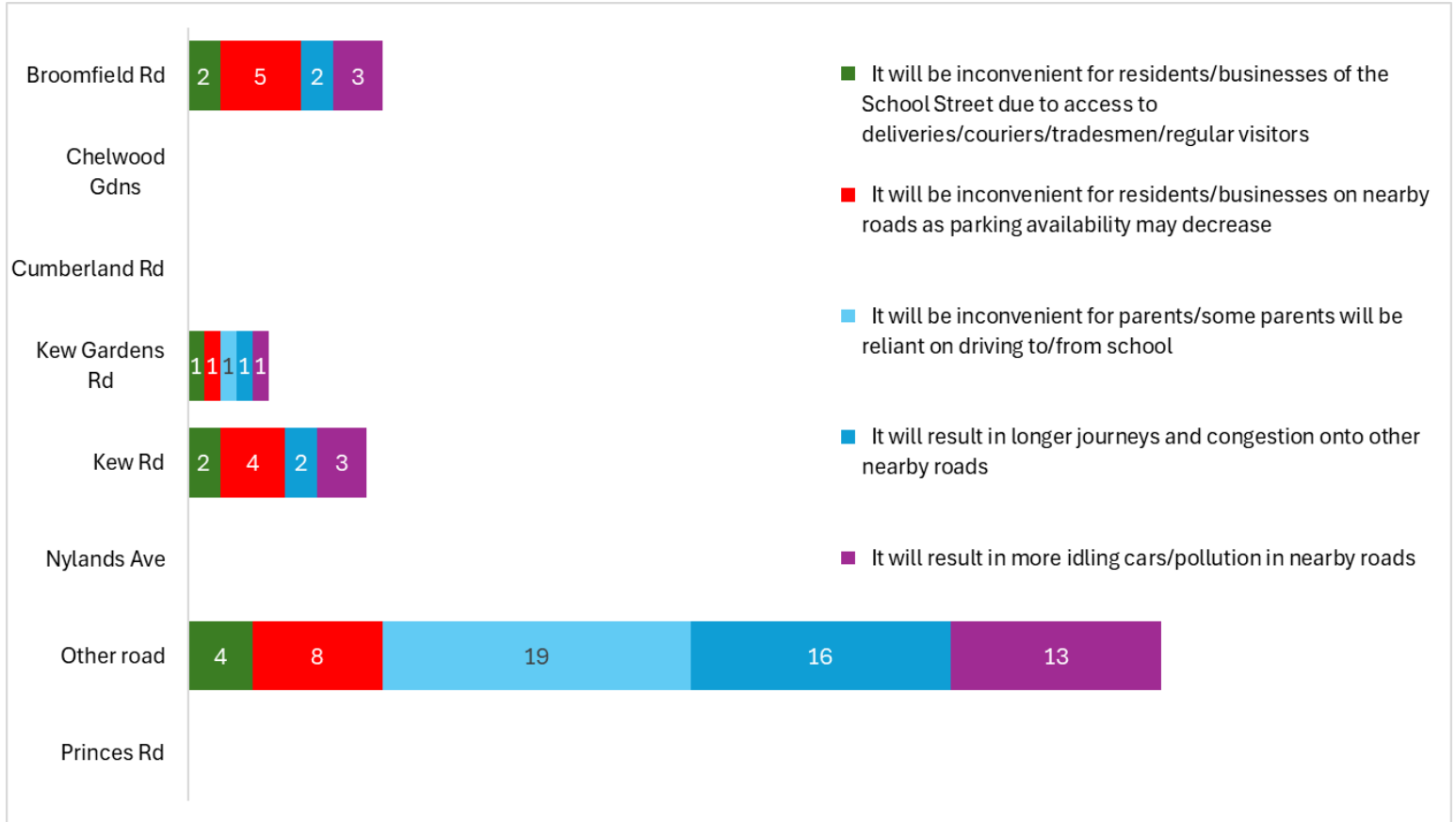

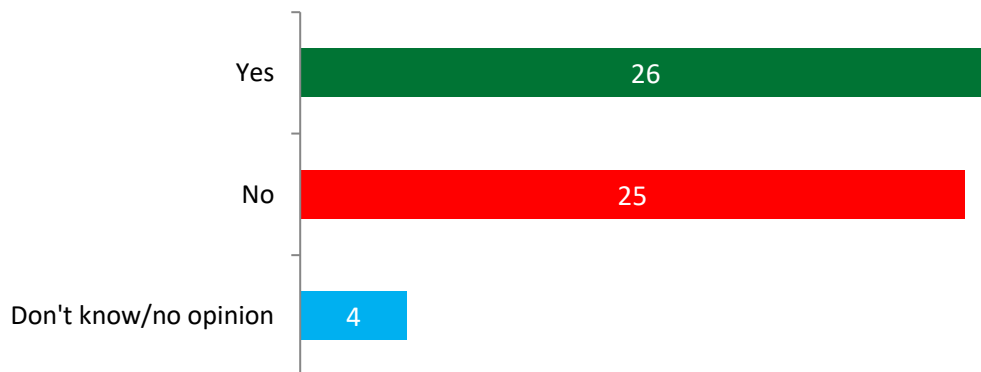

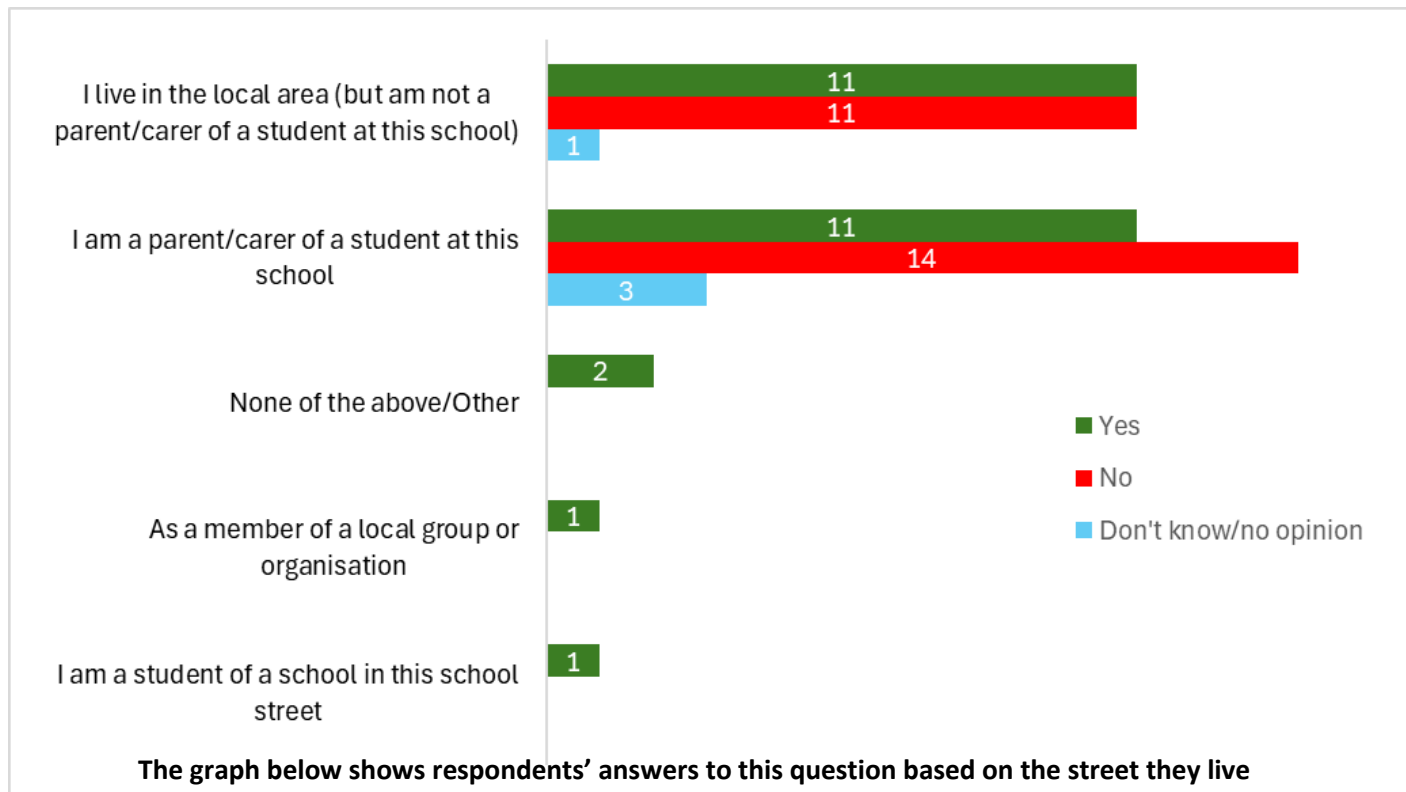
### Do you agree that the proposed hours of operation are suitable to meet the School Streets objectives?

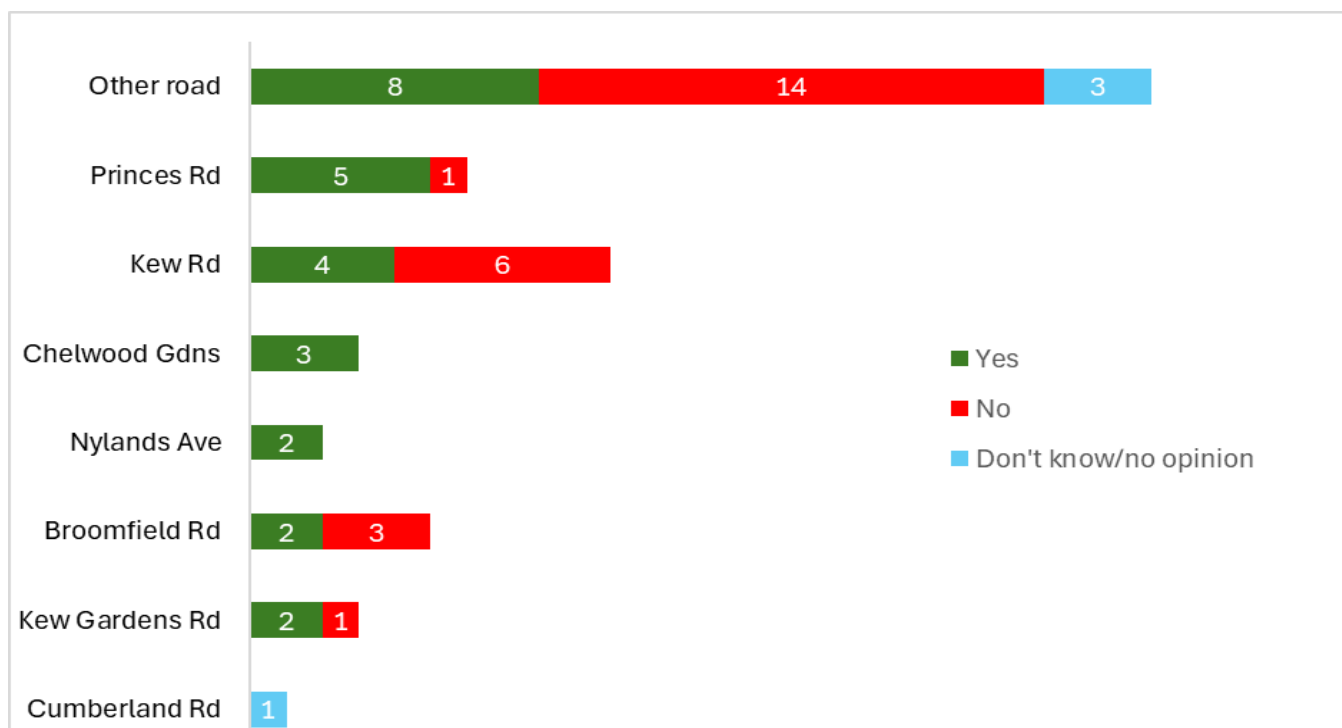

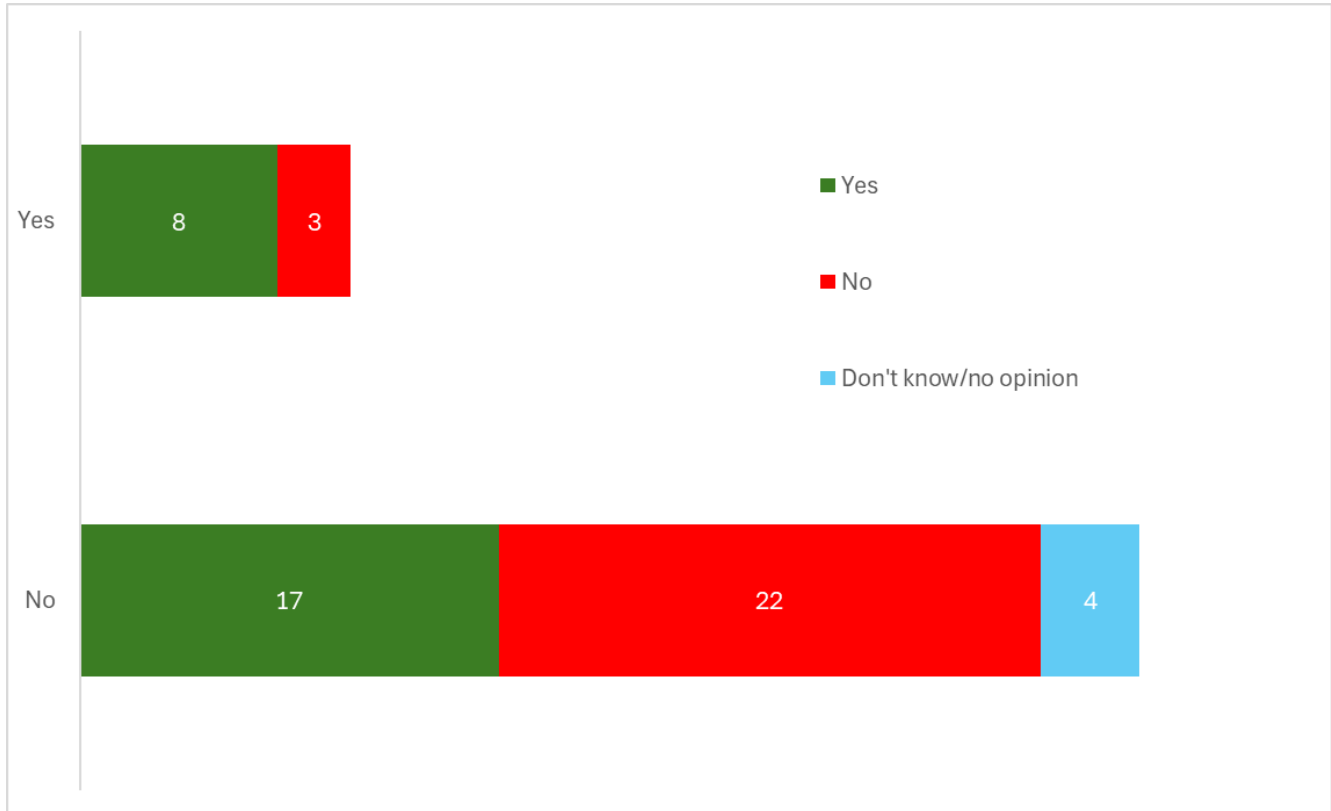

The graph below shows respondents' answers to this question based on the street they live on.



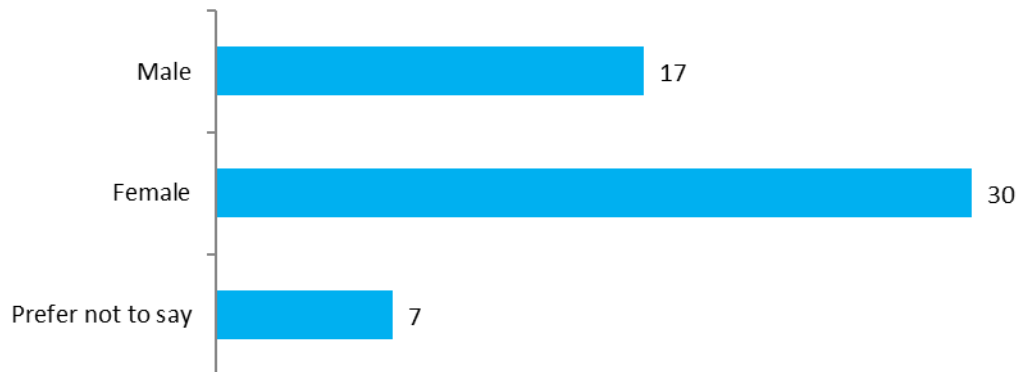
The graph below shows respondents' answers to this question based on whether they live in the School Street restricted area.

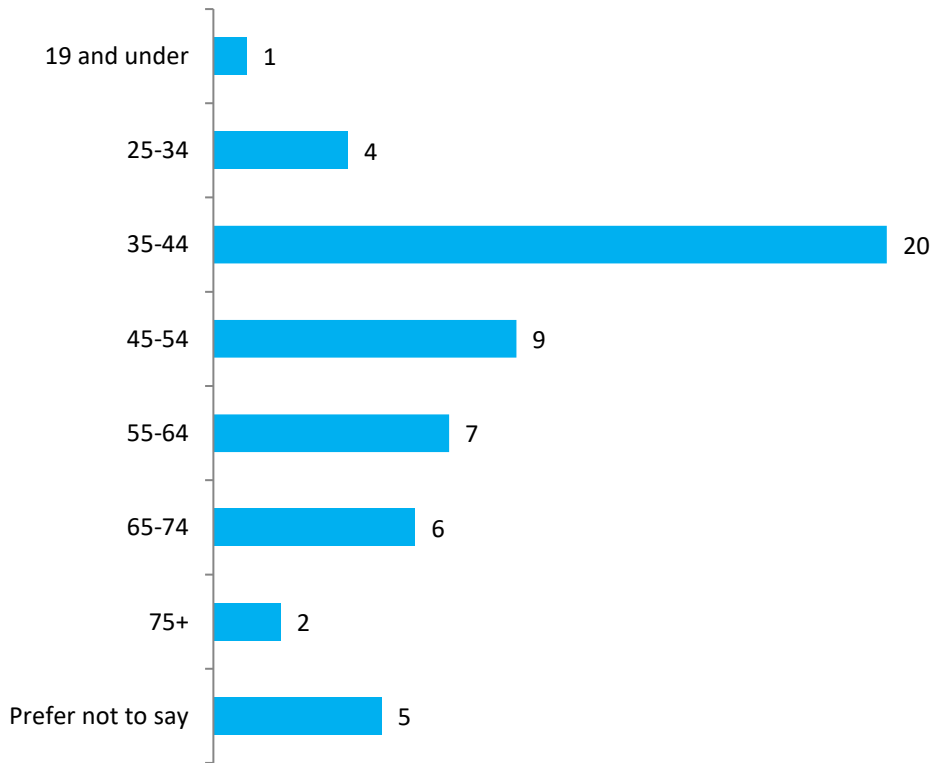

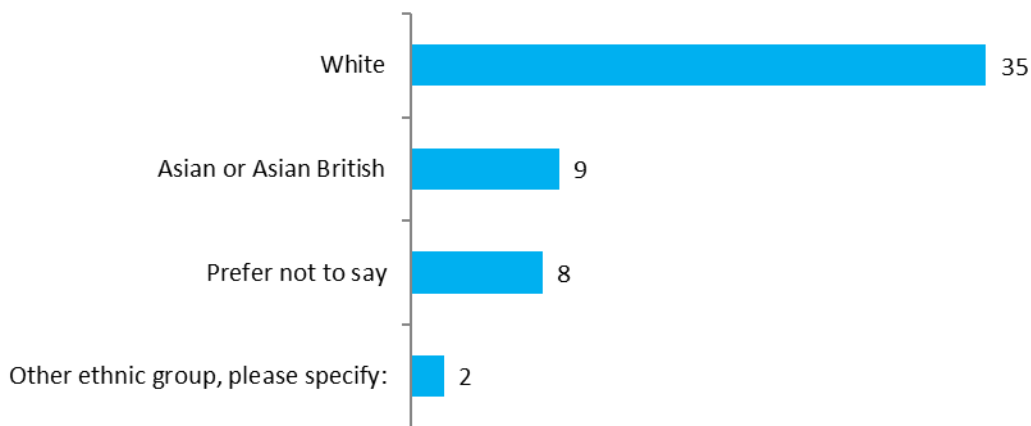

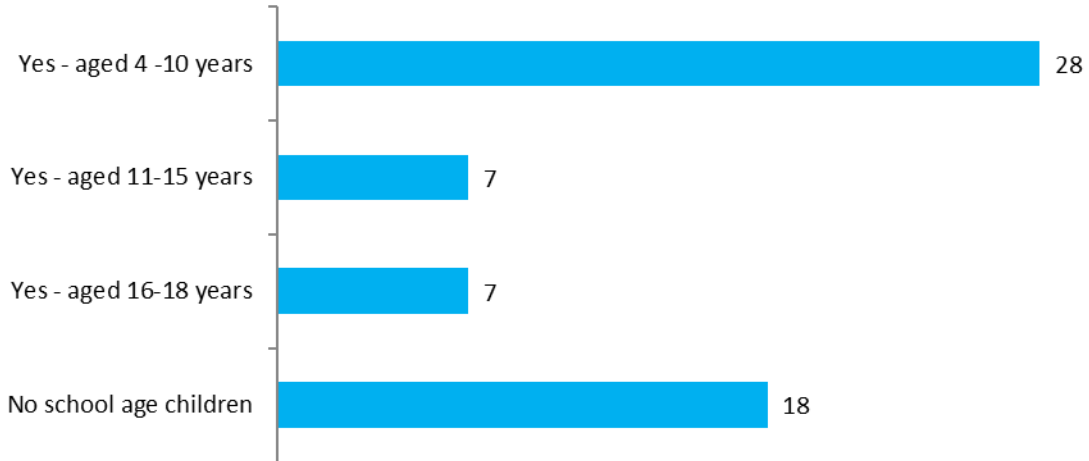

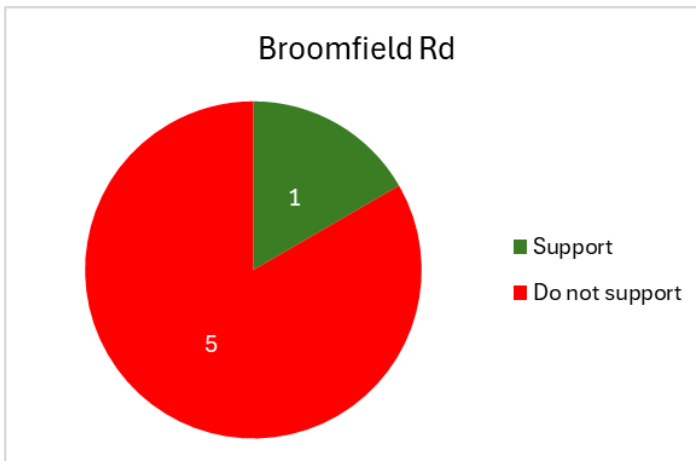

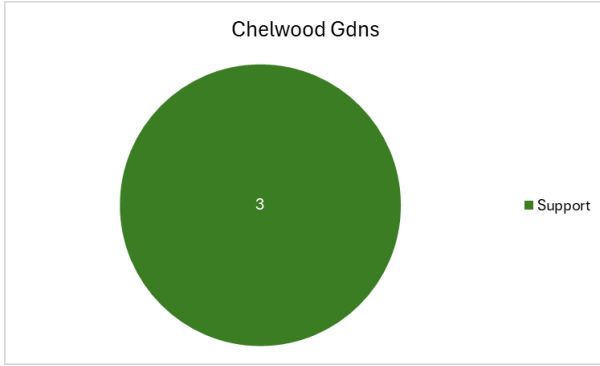

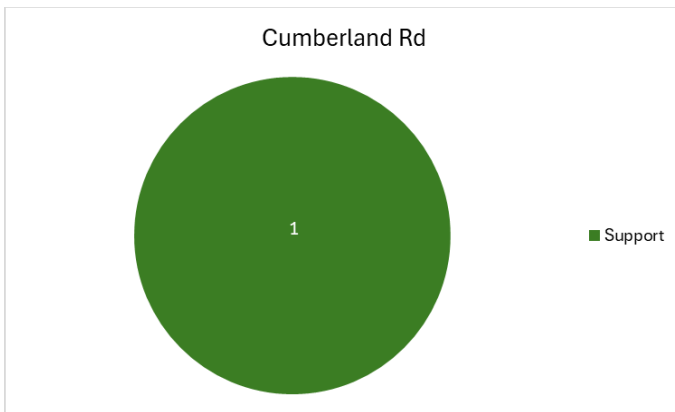

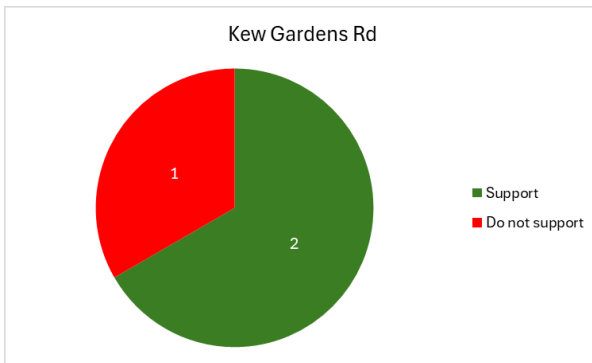

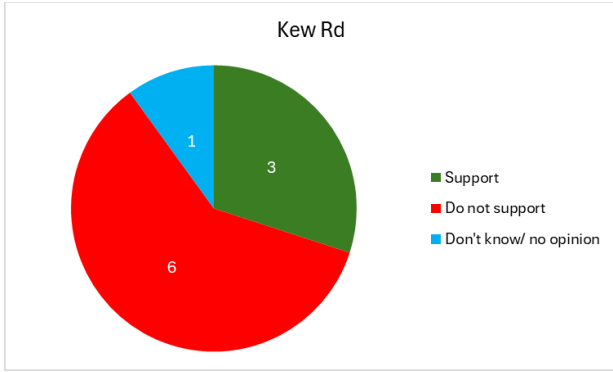
