## Broomfield House School Street – pre trial consultation and drop in session

A School Street proposal is being considered for Broomfield House School on Princes Road. The council would like to hear your views and you are invited to complete our pre-trial consultation survey and attend a drop-in session at the school to speak with borough officers.

A School Street is a scheme to manage traffic outside the school gate during drop-off and pick up times and it operates Monday to Friday term time only in the form of a timed restriction. The suggested hours of operation for a School Street on Princes Road are **8.15 to 9.00AM and 3.00 to 3.45PM**.

Schools Streets allow vehicular access for exempt vehicles such as residents and businesses, blue badge holders, health workers, carers and taxi's visiting properties within the restricted area. More information on who is exempt and who is restricted can be found in the 'exemptions' section of our webpage (linked below). We envisage this proposal will be managed by signage and ANPR cameras are not proposed at this stage.

If agreed, the Council plans to implement a trial School Street in the Autumn term 2025. It is important to note that there will be further opportunities for you to provide feedback on the scheme, if trialed, during the first 6 months whilst the scheme is live.
