TRANSPORT SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT (SPD)

ADOPTION STATEMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Transport Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was formally adopted by the Council on 12 June 2026.

The Transport SPD provides detailed guidance to support the implementation of transport-related policies of the adopted Local Plan (2025) and signposts to relevant external guidance, standards and resources where appropriate. It sets out the Council's expectations on how development should manage and mitigate transport impacts, promote sustainable travel choices, and contribute to safer, healthier and more accessible streets. The Transport SPD forms part of the Council's planning policy framework and is now a material consideration in the determination of planning applications. It replaces the previous Transport Supplementary Planning Document which was last updated in 2020.
