

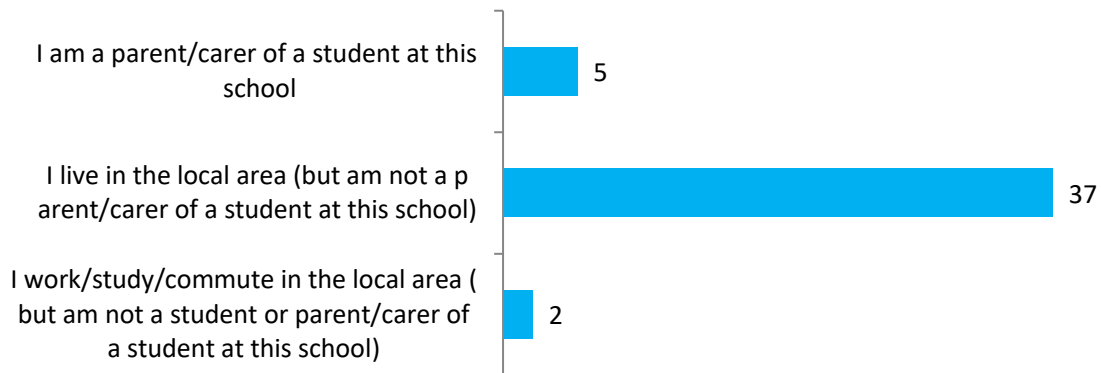

In what capacity are you responding to this School Street consultation?

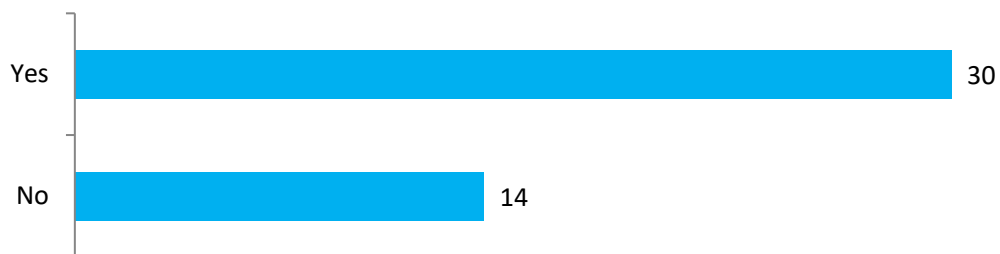

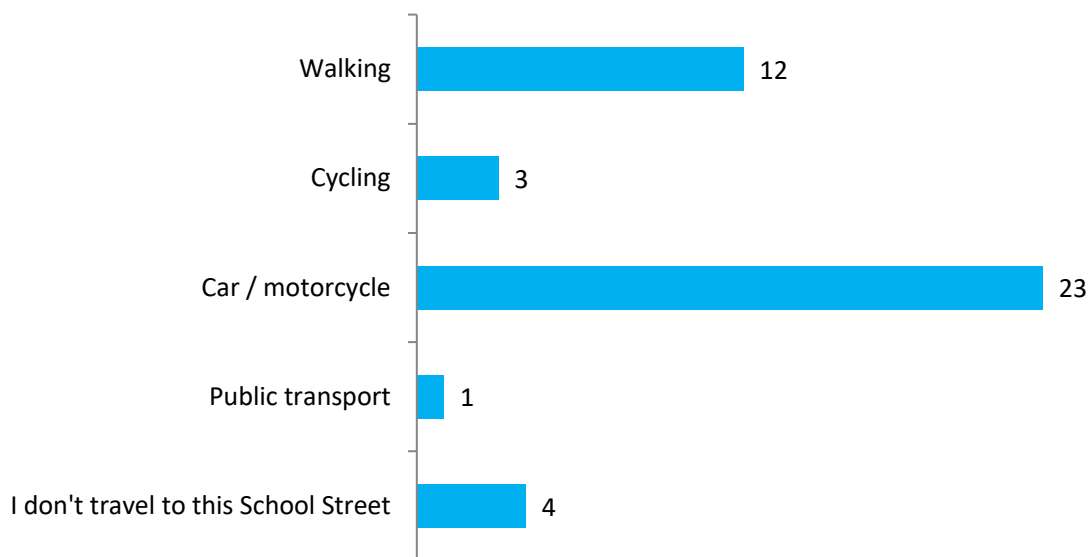

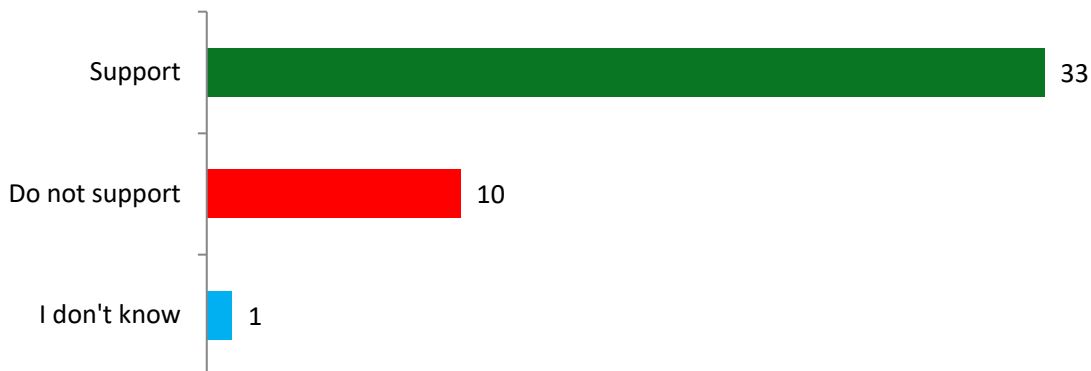

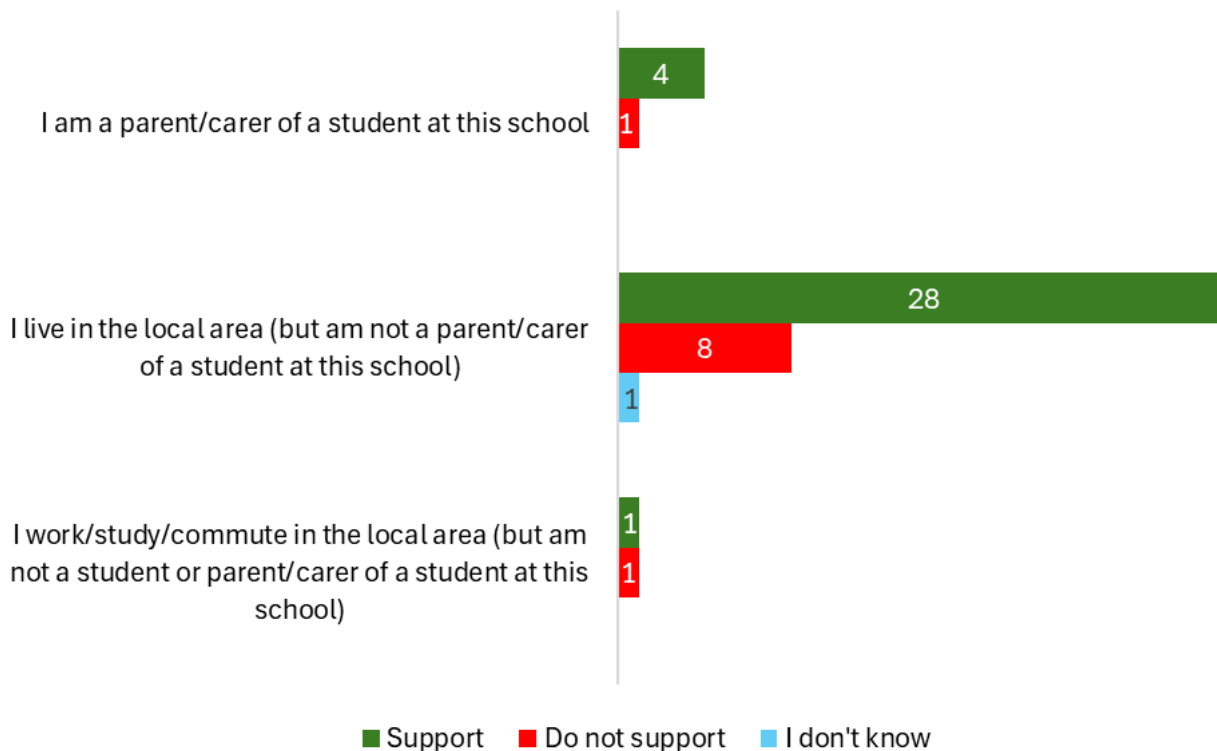

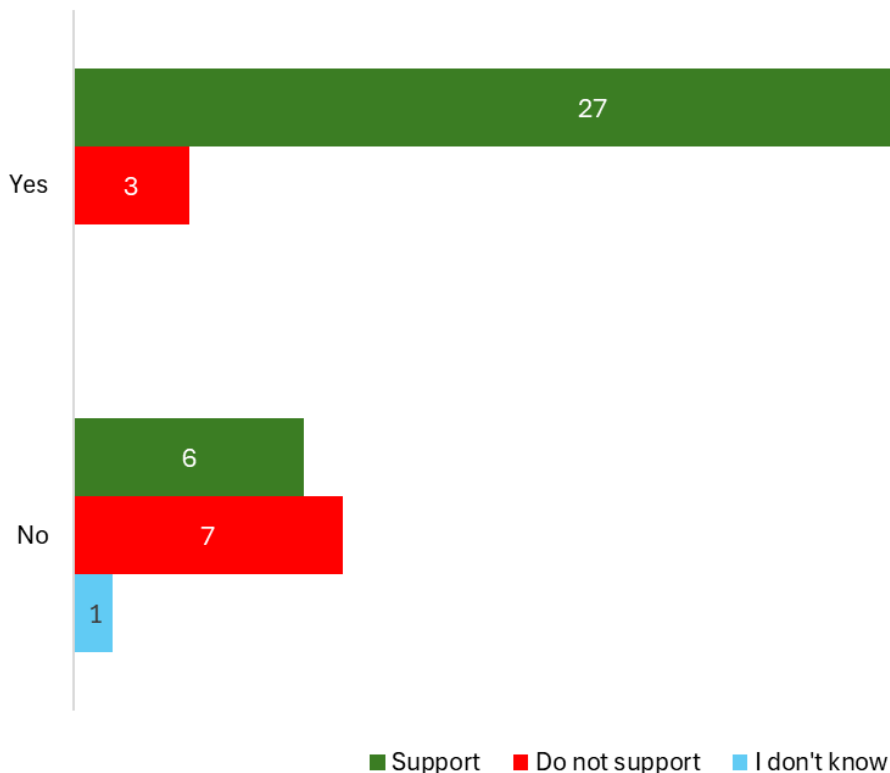

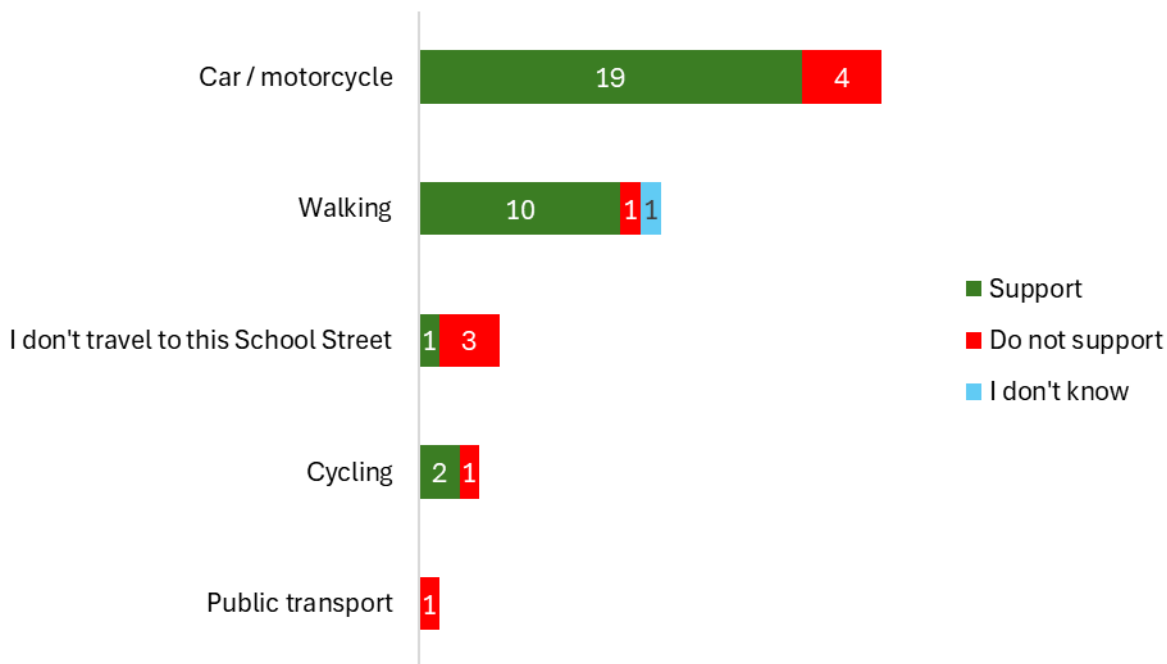
The following graph shows responses to this question based on the capacity in which respondents were responding to the consultation:

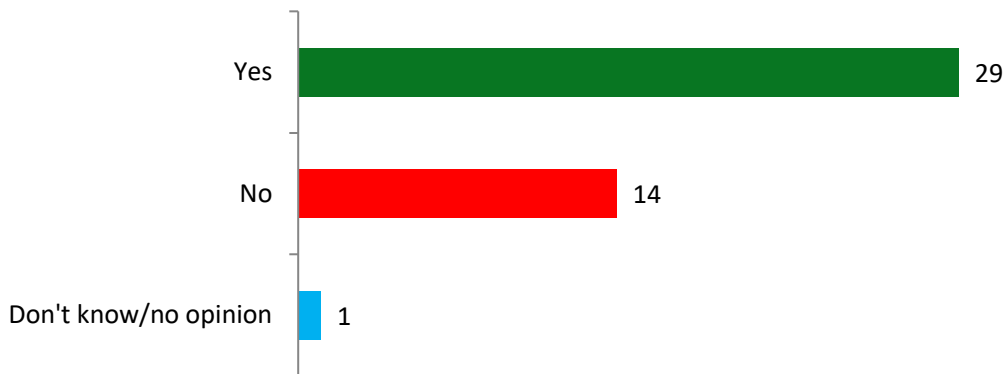


The following graph shows responses to this question based on respondents' MAIN mode of transport for getting to/from the School Street.



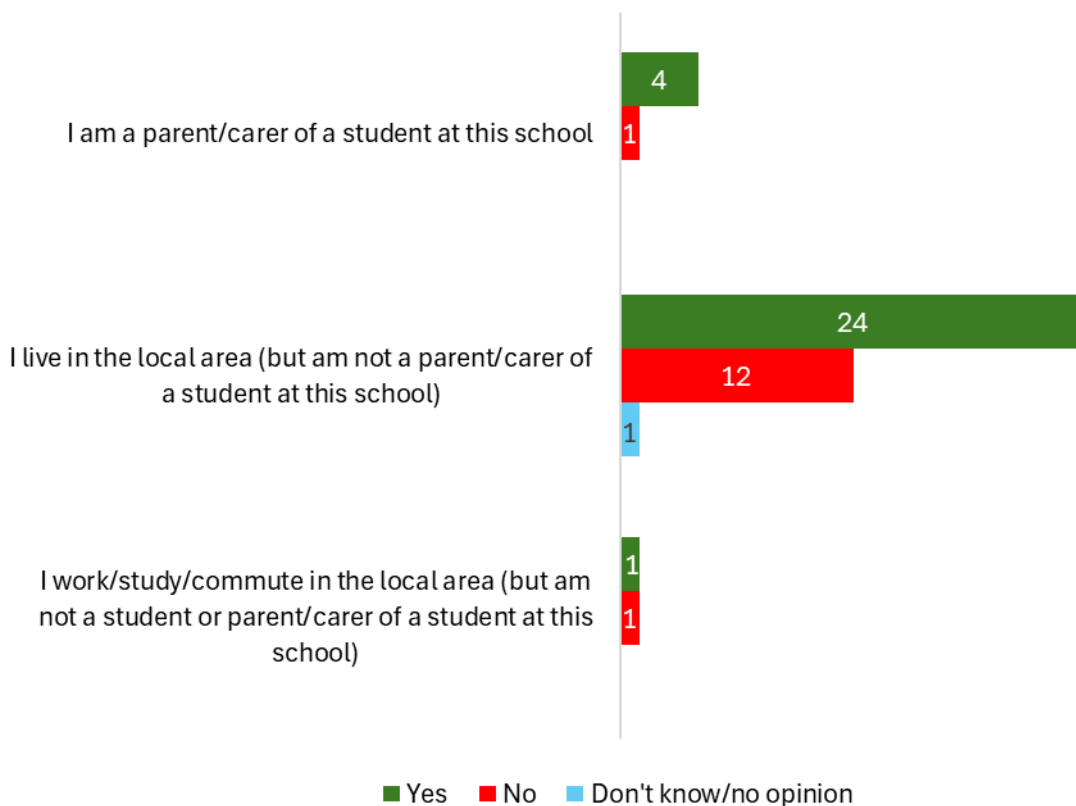
Do you agree that the proposed hours of operation are suitable to meet the School Streets objectives?

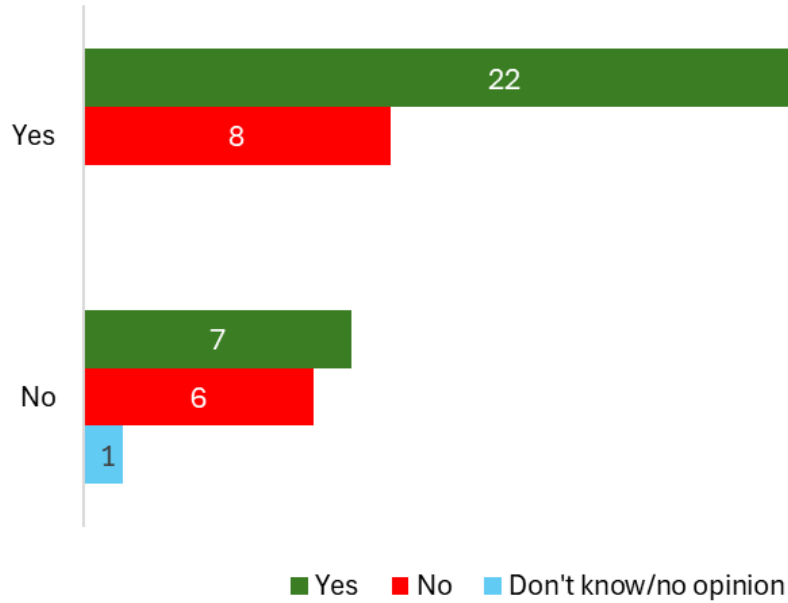

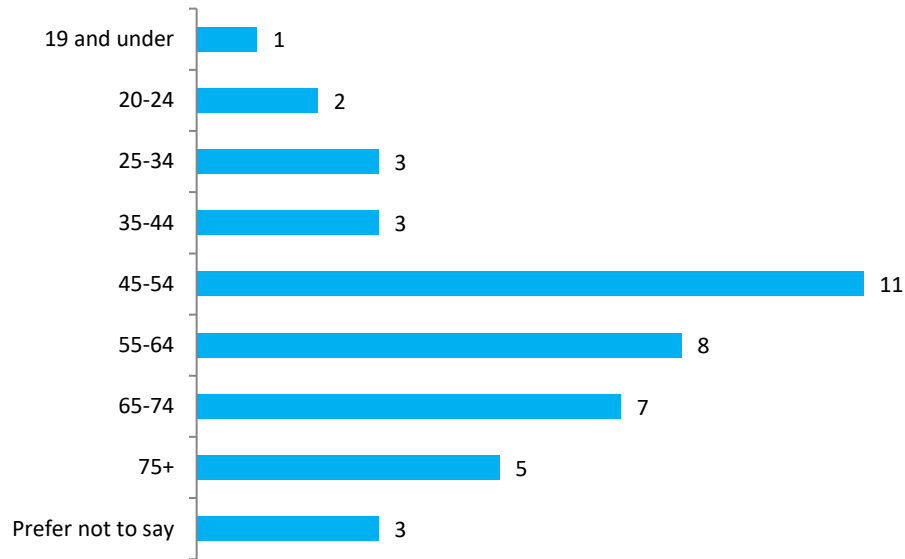

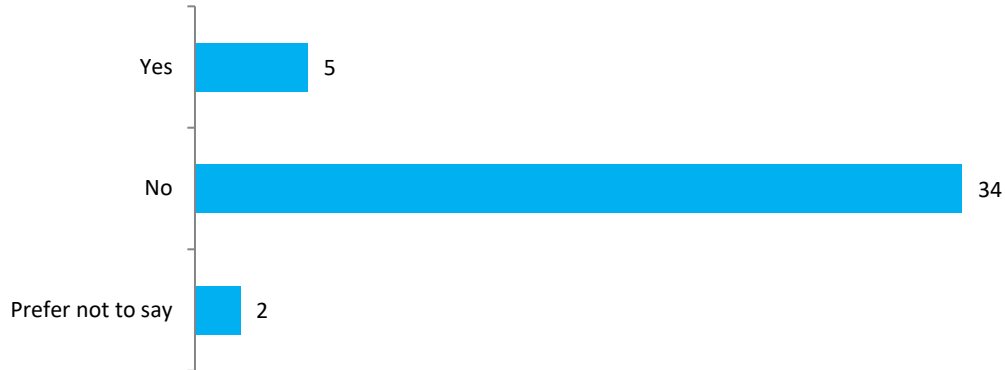

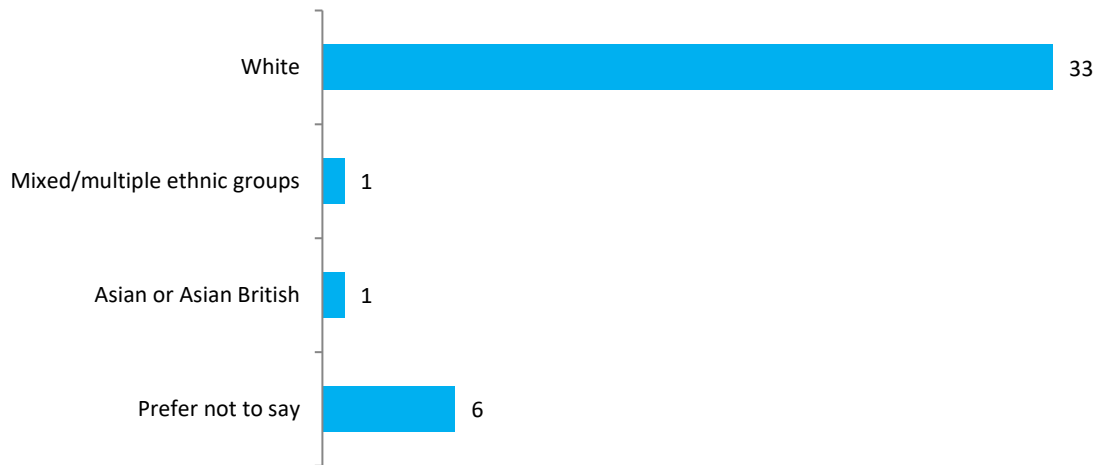

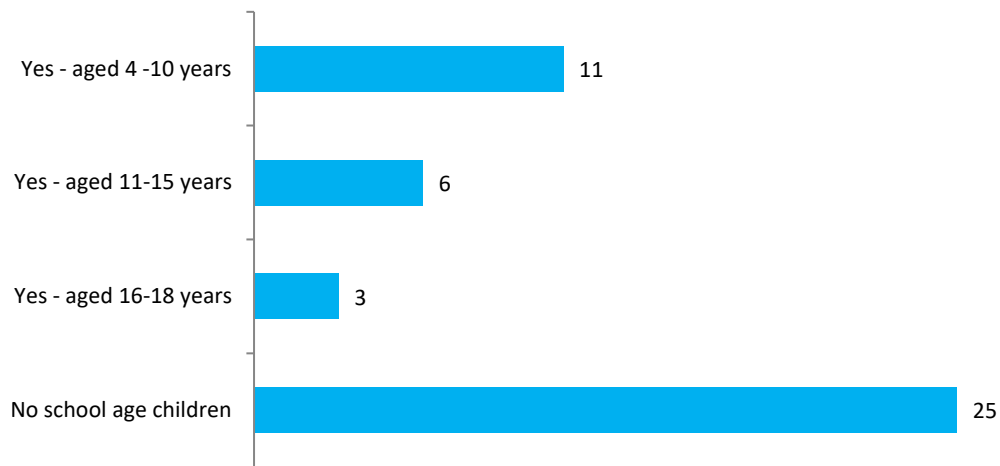
