

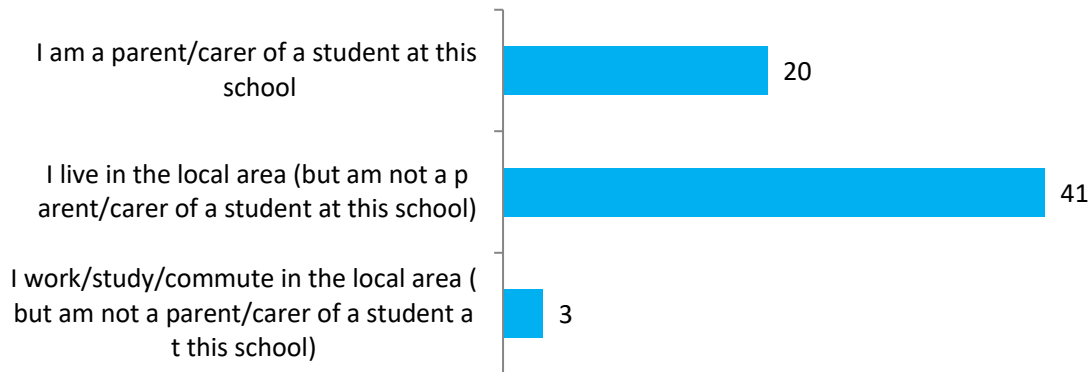

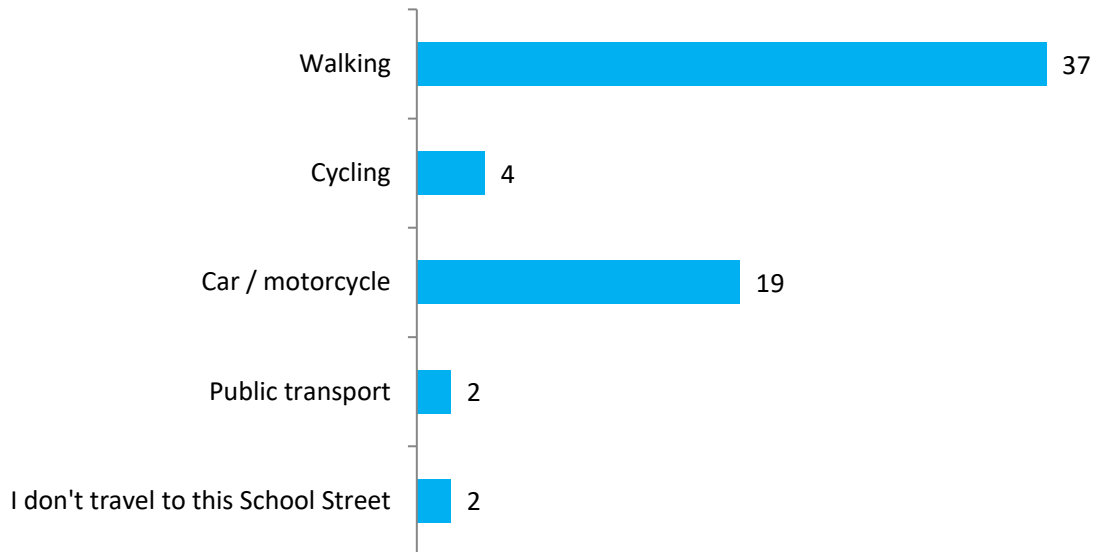

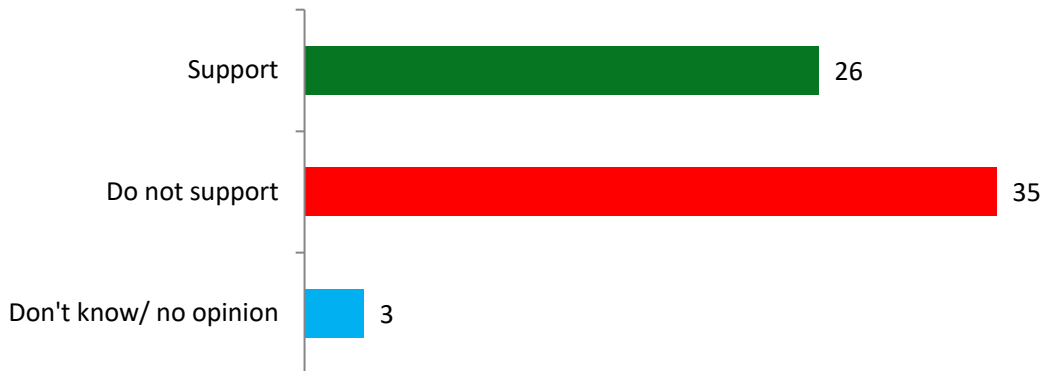

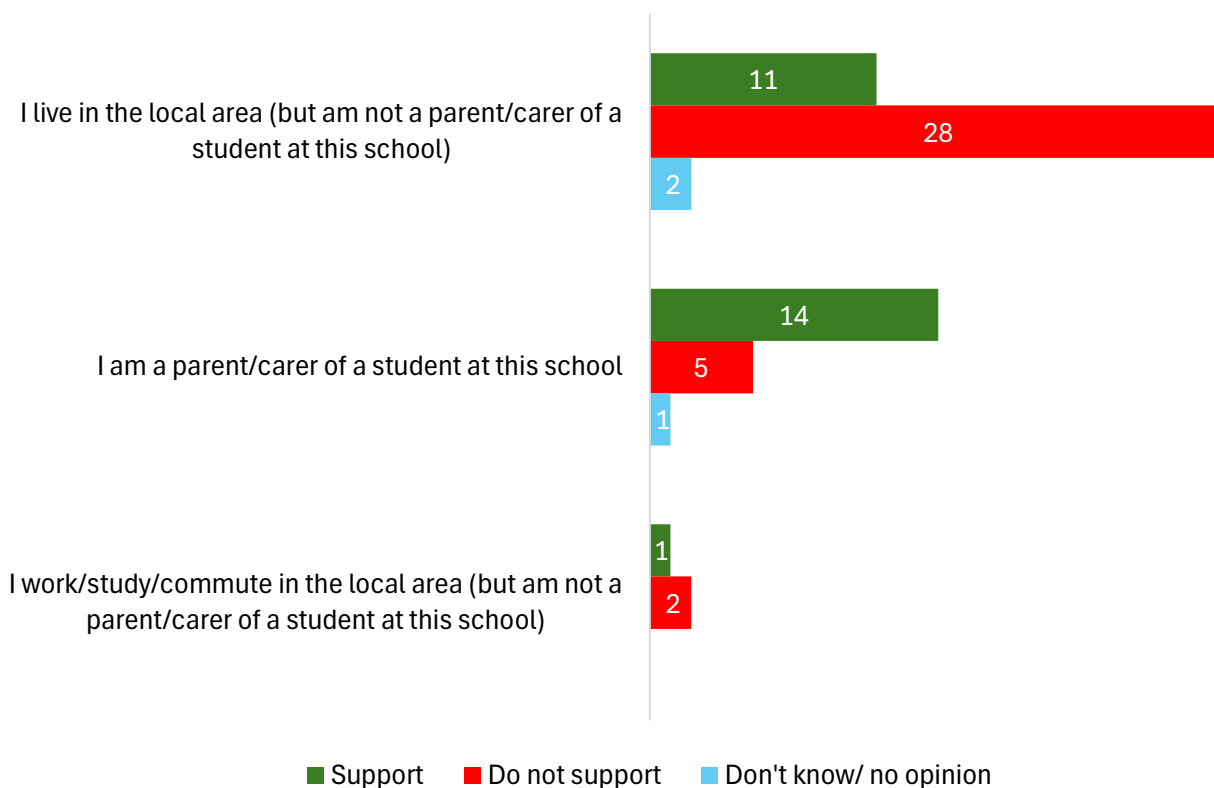

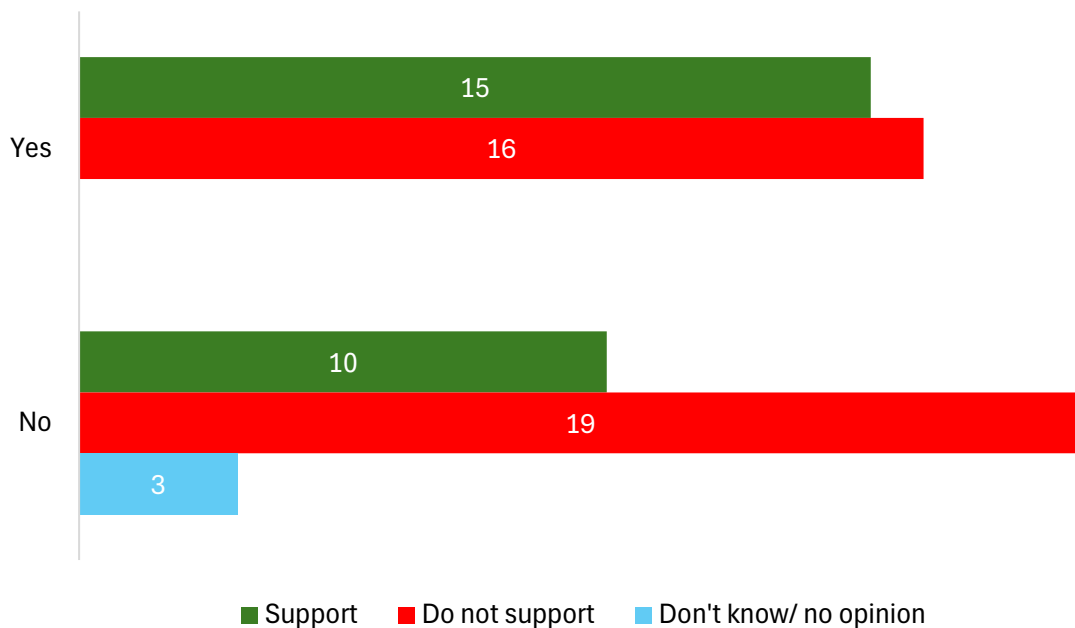

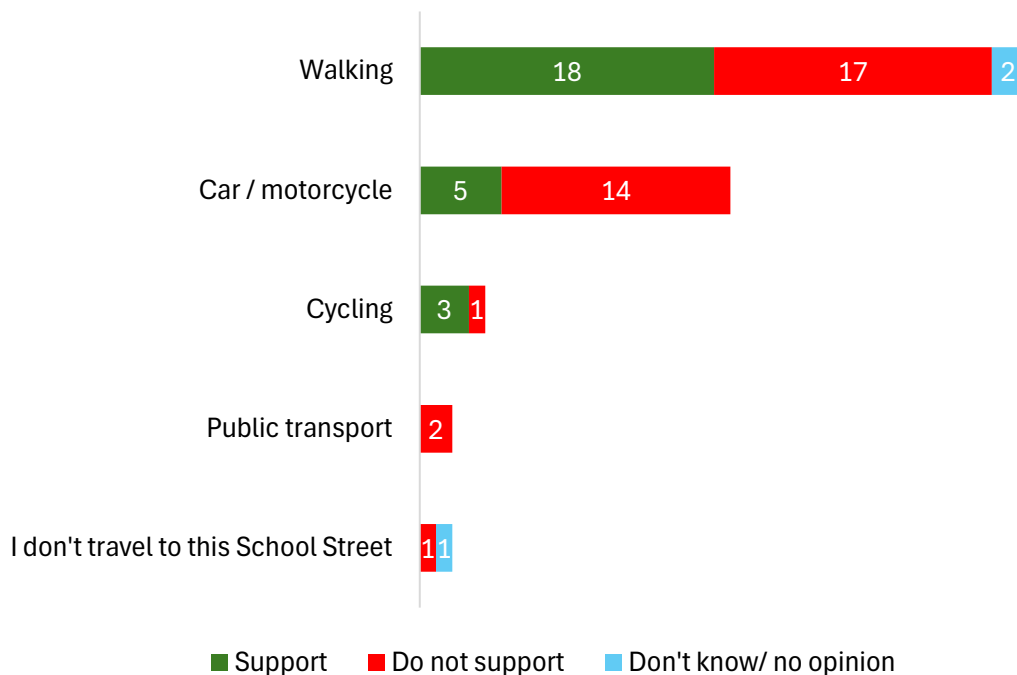
The following graph shows responses to this question based on the capacity in which respondents were responding to the consultation. Parents/carers were more likely to support the school street scheme (70%), compared to those who live in the local area but aren't parents/carers (27%).



The following graph shows responses to this question based on whether respondents live in the School Street restricted area. Those who live in the school street area were more likely to support the scheme (48%), compared to those who live outside the school street area (31%).



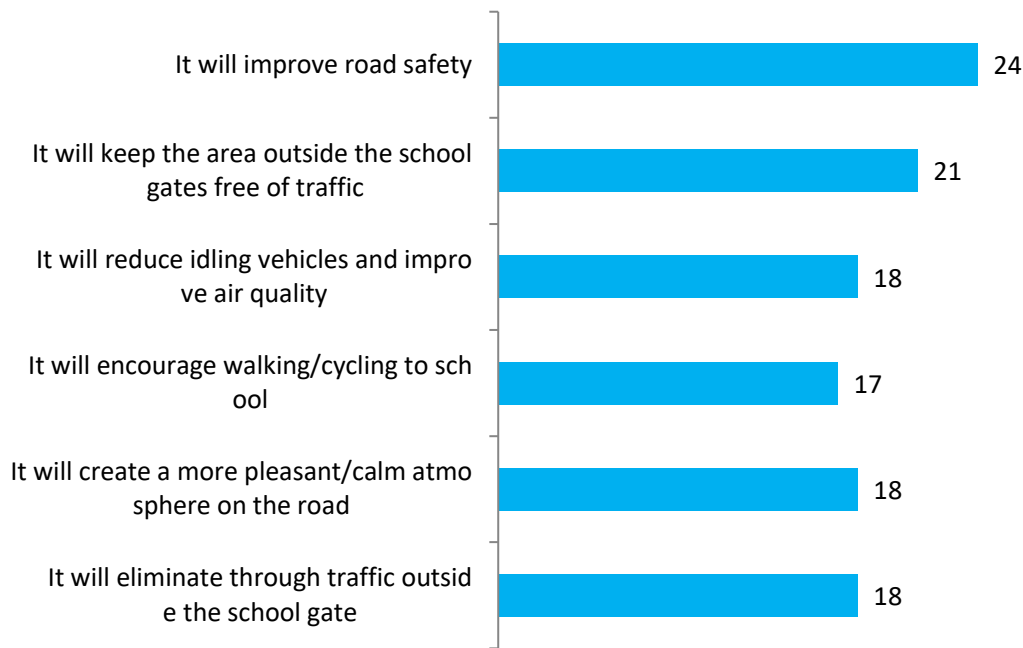

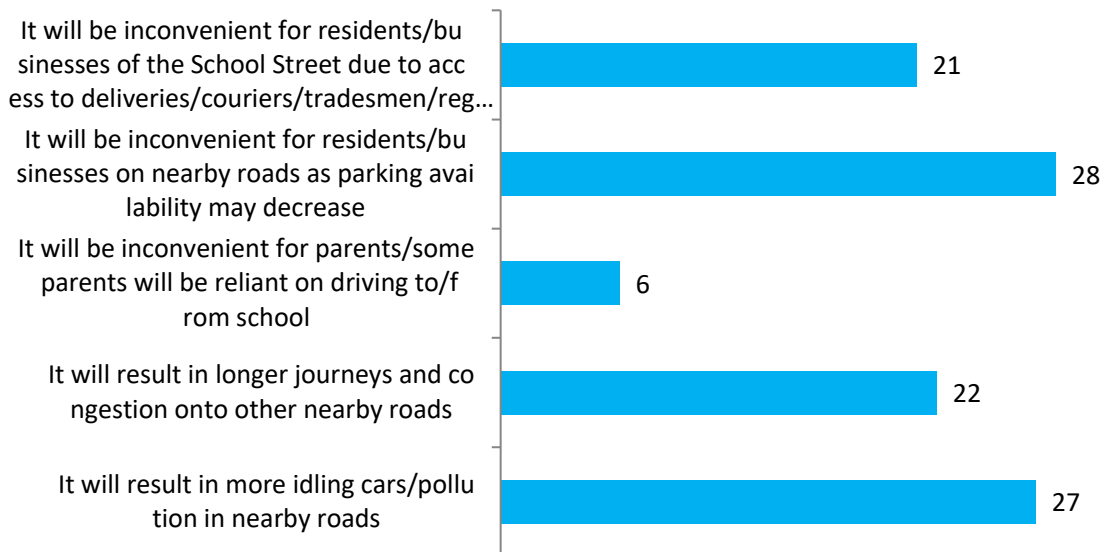

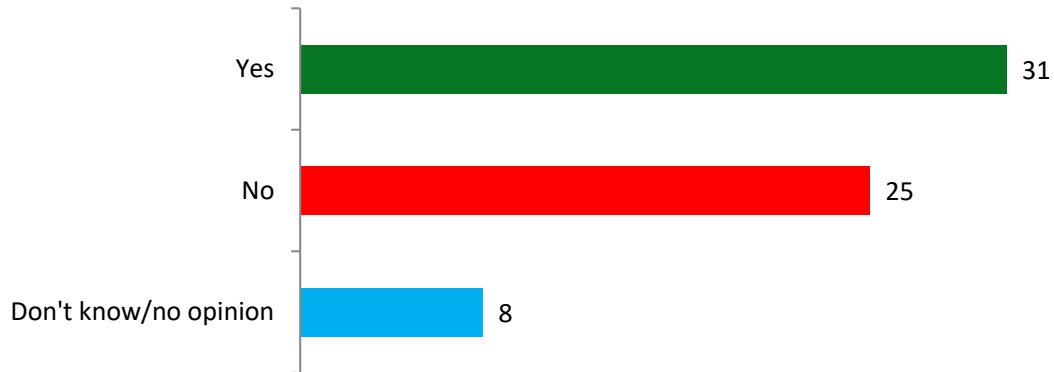

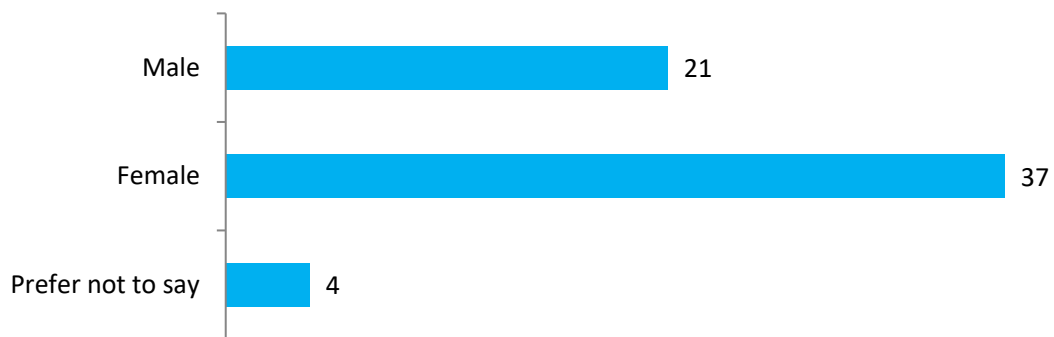

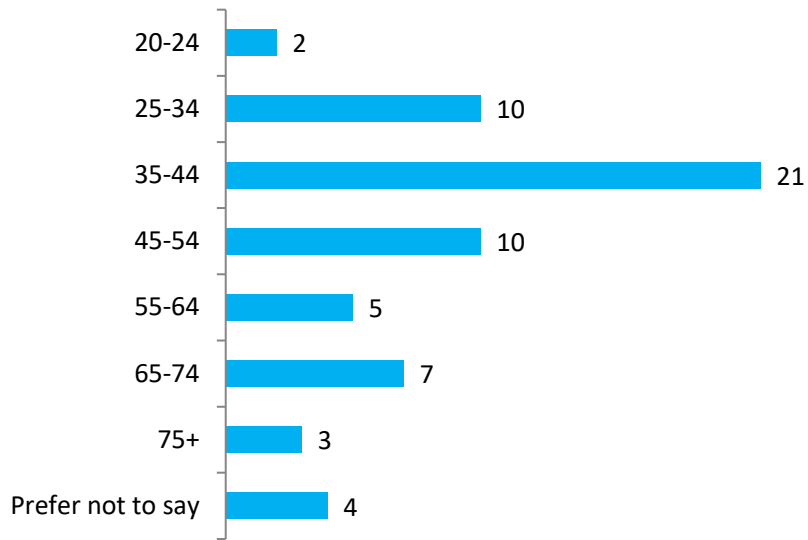

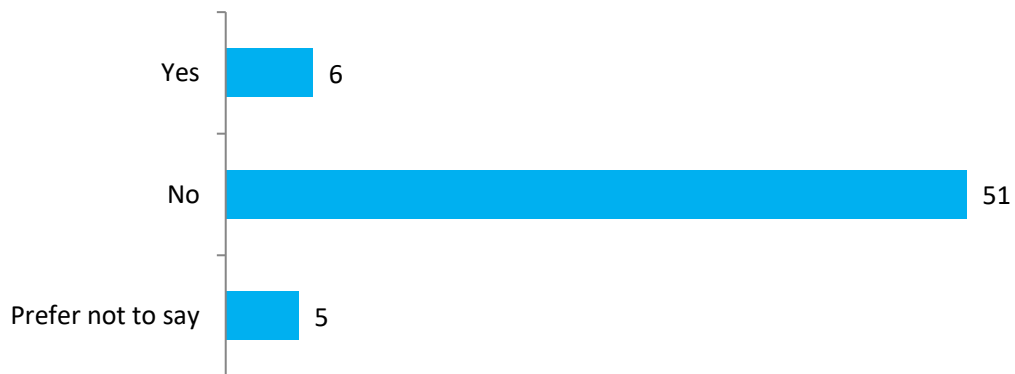

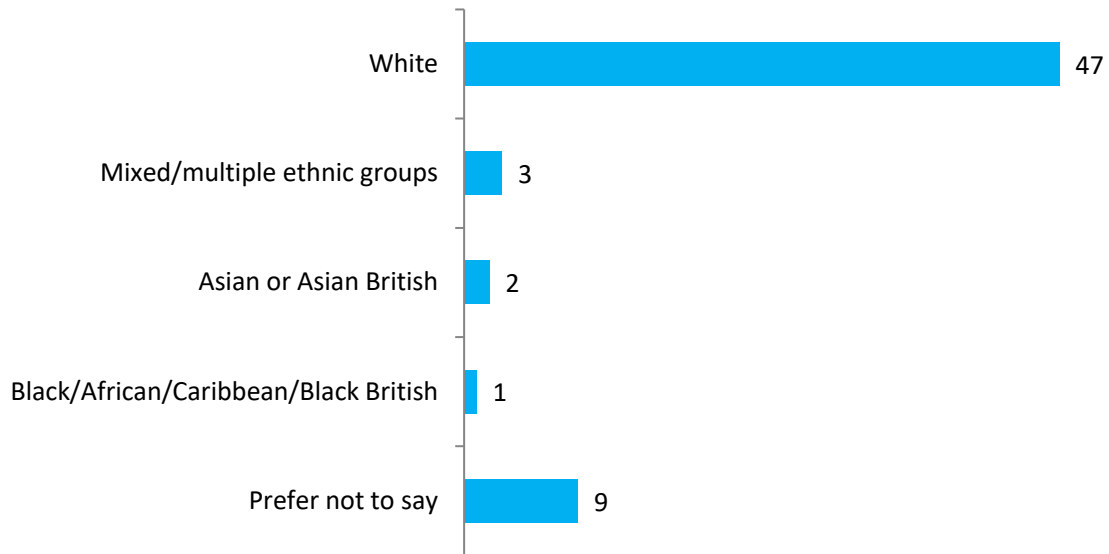

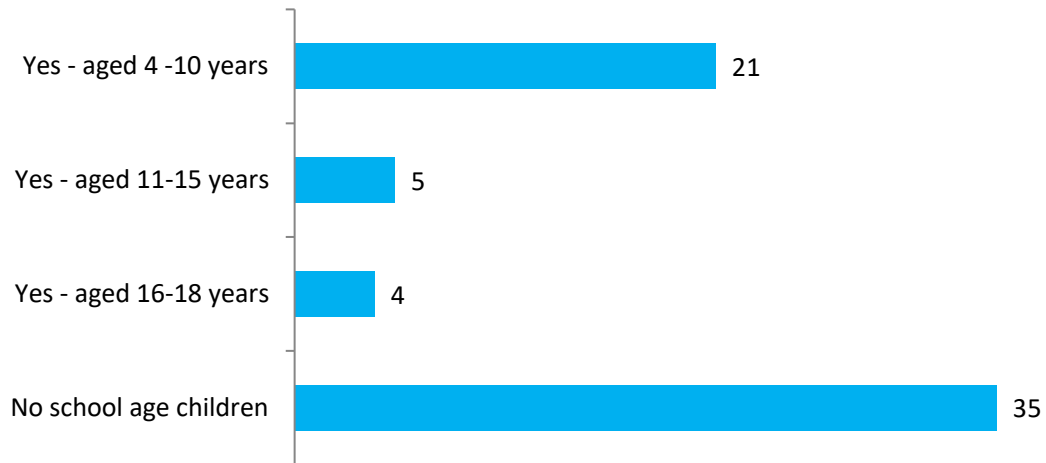
