Teddington Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ), Zone T2 – Proposed extension to Shaef Way

In December 2024, we wrote to inform you of the Council's decision to advertise traffic management orders proposing an extension of Zone T2 to Shaef Way.

Advertisement of Traffic Management Orders

Please be informed that Traffic Management Orders (TMOs) formally proposing the Zone T2 extension operating 10am to noon, Monday to Friday are being advertised on Thursday 10 April 2025 – see attached plan.

Detailed Design

Shaef Way will be signed as a Permit Parking Area which involves less signage and lining (reduced clutter). The design of these schemes allows for parking to take place mostly as it does now but with the requirement for a valid parking permit to be on display on parked vehicles during the operational hours/days of the scheme as stated above. This includes residents (and their visitors) parking across their own driveway provided a yellow line has not been put in place.

We are also proposing some short lengths of no waiting 'At Any Time' restrictions (double yellow lines) in Shaef Way to improve sight lines and access.

If Shaef Way is added to Zone T2 residents and their visitors parking on street during the operational period in this part of the zone (10am to noon, Monday to Friday) will be required to purchase and display a valid parking permit. You will not be able to purchase a permit if you live in a property subject to a s106 Planning Agreement which restricts or prohibits the issue of permits.

Details of Zone T2 parking permit prices from 1 July 2025 are as follows:

Permit Type	Cost
Resident	£66.00 per year
Resident Visitor	£1.70 per day
Business	£220.90 per year

Resident and Business permits

The above resident and business permit prices are for the first permit issued per household/business for one year. Subsequent resident permits purchased per year are approximately 100% more for the second permit and 200% more for the third and further permits issued. Subsequent business permits purchased are approximately 50% more for the second permit purchased per year and 50% again for third and further permits issued. These charges are based on the first permit price.

Resident visitor permits

Resident visitor permits (scratch cards) are available at half the standard price to the over 60s. These permits must be validated for the relevant time period.
