ADOPTION STATEMENT

Notice is hereby given that the Local Views Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was formally adopted by the Council on 11 June 2026.

The new Local Views SPD, produced to support implementation of the adopted Local Plan (2025), sets out the details of the range of prospects, linear and townscape views, which are highly important, including in the borough's riverside and open space settings. The Local Views SPD forms part of the Council's planning policy framework and is now a material consideration in the determination of planning applications.
