

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

THE LONDON BOROUGH OF RICHMOND UPON THAMES (PRESCRIBED ROUTE) (No. 1) EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2025

Made: 18 June 2025

Coming into operation: 30 June 2025

The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 9 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), as amended, hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984” and all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order —

1. This Order shall come into operation on 30 June 2025 and may be cited as the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames (Prescribed Route) (No. 1) Experimental Order 2025.
2.
 - (1) In this Order the expression “enactment” means any enactment whether public, general or local and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.
 - (2) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
 - (3) The Interpretation Act 1978^(b) shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. Except as provided in Article 4, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter Willow Way at its junction with Bye Ways between 7.00am and 10.00am on Mondays to Fridays inclusive

4. Nothing in Article 3 to this Order will apply to: -

- (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform.
- (b) pedal cycles;
- (c) any motor vehicle which has been granted exemption from the prohibitions as arranged and managed by the Council.
- (d) any person in charge of a vehicle being used for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the highway or the cleansing of gullies, the laying, erection alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any electronic communications apparatus or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign
- (e) any person using a vehicle for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes [or the purposes of a statutory undertaker in an emergency].
- (f) the purpose of exercising any statutory power or performing any statutory power or performing any statutory duty;
- (g) any person who causes or permits a vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

5. In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the Director of Environment and Community Services of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames, as the specified officer, or some person authorised in that behalf by that officer may, if it appears to that officer or to that person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend this Order or any provision thereof.

The purpose of this Order is to introduce a motor vehicle prohibition for motor vehicles between 7am and 10am on Mondays to Fridays inclusive in Willow Way, Twickenham.
